



**PROFESSIONAL
FABRIC DYES**

Dypro Multi-Purpose Dye: DYEING FEATHERS

You will need:

- Feathers
- Dypro Multi-Purpose Dye
- 250ml Vinegar
- Rubber Gloves

Method

1. Wash feathers in warm soapy water, handle gently.
2. Dissolve correct amount of dye (see reference chart) in 500ml boiling water.
3. Fill container with enough boiling water to cover feathers (container may stain).
4. Add dye solution and vinegar.
5. Add feathers and gently agitate until they are one shade darker than required.
(For lighter shades, this may only take a few seconds, for darker shades, a few minutes).
6. Rinse in water, shaking gently. Place on kitchen roll to dry. Re-shape whilst damp.

Colour Number / Amount of Dye Powder to Use Per 500g/1lb of Fabric:

Colour Number	02, 09, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16, 18, 19, 21, 22, 25, 26, 28, 32, 33, 34, 39, 44, 53	05, 07, 17	08
Amount of Dye Per 500g/1lb of Fabric	10g	12g	16g
