

## **Dypro Multi-Purpose Dye: DYEING FEATHERS**

## You will need:

- Feathers
- Dypro Multi-Purpose Dye
- 250ml Vinegar
- Rubber Gloves

## **Method**

- 1. Wash feathers in warm soapy water, handle gently.
- 2. Dissolve correct amount of dye (see reference chart) in 500ml boiling water.
- 3. Fill container with enough boiling water to cover feathers (container may stain).
- 4. Add dye solution and vinegar.
- Add feathers and gently agitate until they are one shade darker than required.
  (For lighter shades, this may only take a few seconds, for darker shades, a few minutes).
- 6. Rinse in water, shaking gently. Place on kitchen roll to dry. Re-shape whilst damp.
