

Dypro Multi-Purpose Dye: SATIN SHOES

- Satin shoes can be coloured simply and easily with Dypro Multi-Purpose Dye
- The satin retains its sheen after dyeing
- As the colour is brushed on to the surface the shade achieved may not be exactly the same as that obtained when treating fabric by immersion
- BLACK cannot be guaranteed with Multi-Purpose Dye
- Do not use of silk shoes

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How to Use

- Shoes should be clean and free from stains, as dye will not cover bad blemishes.
- 2. Pad the insides of the shoes with clean paper. Light dampen the surface with cold water.
- 3. Wear rubber gloves. Shake correct amount of powder (see reference chart) gently into a heatproof jug (not plastic). Add 500ml / 1 pint of boiling water.
 Stir well until the powder is dissolved thoroughly. DO NOT ADD SALT.
- 4. Apply solution with a small stiff brush, using a light circular motion, to work the colour into the satin.
- 5. If necessary repeat the process: Each application will deepen the colour. Wait until the shoes are dry before evaluating colour result. If more than one coat is required the solution should be reheated it must always be applied hot.

Colour Number / Amount of Dye Powder to Use Per 500g/1lb of Fabric:

Amount of Dye Per 500g/1lb of Fabric	10g	12g	16g
