


3. When the Village receives its reimbursement money or repayment money for the \$5,000.00 advance, it will instead retain only \$2,500.00 of that advance and will pay to Margaret


Lucille Haas the other \$2,500.00 as a reimbursement or payment to her for expenses that she has incurred in maintaining the property throughout the grant application and completion process.

4. The Village will only assume title and ownership of the property when it is determined that it is not at risk relating to underground tanks, soil contamination, or other volatile conditions or provisions which will place it at risk for penalties, fines, or other action by the Ohio EPA or other regulatory agencies.

It was moved by Rick Bednarki and seconded by Donna Hesser to waive the requirement of three readings and to pass this Ordinance on a single reading as an emergency measure and the Council voted 5-0 to pass it on an emergency basis. It was then moved by Russ Hogue and seconded by Dione Campbell to effect passage of this Ordinance and again the vote was 5-0.

This Ordinance, shall, therefore, become effective as soon as allowable by law.
