# CANBERRA OPEN 2025

## Tournament overview

Expanding from successful events in 2023 and 2024, event sponsors **Mungovan Air-Conditioning, Panasaless and Panasonic, Comprehensive Dental Care, Spectrum Solar and Electrical, Independent Plumbing and Gas Fitting, Uprise Accounting, Canberra Pool Builders, Uprise Accounting, Carter + Co, Six8 Coffee Roasters, Sound CBR, PAAK, Abode Woden and BPD Bowling Australia** in conjunction with the NSW Regional Bowling Tour and Zone Bowling Tuggeranong are proud to bring you the return of the **Canberra Open 2025!**

This is a TBA accredited event including both open (scratch) and graded (handicap) divisions, all TBA rules and regulations will apply. Participants must be 2025 TBA members can only enter in one division. Any matters not covered in this entry form, including any appeals or protests, will be at the discretion of the tournament directors and NSW RBT committee. Bowlers in the graded division will need to provide evidence of their highest average over 18 or more games as of 31 December 2024, to be eligible this average must be 189 or lower, this average will be used to determine their handicap based on 90% of 10 pins above the highest entering average. The tournament directors have the right to regrade any bowler's average where this is deemed necessary.

Bowlers will be required to pay a non-refundable \$75 deposit per entry to secure their place in the event, all first entries will included 2 squads, re-entries will include 1 squad. Squads will be limited to a maximum of **20 bowlers in each division** for a total of 40 bowlers (squads may be reduced further if there are limited entries in the lead up to the event). Each bowler will be entered into a draw to win a bowling ball donated by **BPD Bowling Australia**, this will be drawn during the presentation (approx. 12:45pm) and winners **must be** present to be able to claim the prize.

## Qualifying

Best 2 x 3 game squads for a total of 6 qualifying games. At the completion of all qualifying squads, the top 24 open bowlers based on pinfall and **top 24** graded bowlers based on pinfall plus handicap will progress to the elimination finals.

Ties for progressing to the elimination finals or for seeding positions will be broken by highest last game until the tie is broken.

## Elimination finals

**Check in closes at 8:30am.** Bowlers will be seeded in the elimination bracket based on their qualifying position. The top 8 open bowlers and **top 8** graded bowlers will receive a bye in round 1 and will not compete in this round. Rounds 1 and 2 will be a 3 game block, rounds 3, 4 and 5 will be a single game, with the highest pinfall (plus handicap for graded) from each match progressing to the next round.

Ties for progressing to the next match in rounds 1 and 2 will be broken by highest last game, for ties unable to be broken with highest last game in rounds 1 and 2, or for any ties in rounds 3, 4 and 5, this will trigger a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off (including 1/5 of a bowlers handicap in the graded division). Prizes and ranking points will be awarded to bowlers who are eliminated in the same round based on the order of their qualifying position.

The bowler remaining in each division at the end of the elimination finals will be the **Canberra Open 2025 Champions** winning a guaranteed \$1,250 + a pair of True Wireless Noise Cancelling Earphones valued at \$250 thanks to **Panasonic**.
