Tournament Conditions

- This is a TBA Accredited Event, all TBA Rules and Regulations apply.
- This is a scratch and graded event with only 1 qualifying attempt.
- The graded division is handicapped at 90% of 200 (or 90% of 10 pins over the highest entering average, whichever is higher). Bowlers with an average equal to or below 189 as at **28/09/2025** or who have been eligible for any other graded event during 2025 will qualify for the graded division.
- Handicaps will be applied to the graded division based on the bowler's average at the cutoff date.
- Bowlers may only bowl in one division.
- Tournament committee reserves the right to re-grade bowlers when necessary.
- All bowlers must wear a bowling shirt or collared shirt. Male bowlers are required to wear tailored pants or shorts. Females are required to wear skirts, tailored pants, shorts or skorts. Bowlers are required to dress for the event with a sense of respectability.
- Spectators are not to go into the players area at any time.
- Bowlers are required to stay on their allocated lanes only moving with lane changes.
- Any protests must be lodged with the tournament committee within 15 mins of completion of bowling in which the incident occurred.
- Any matter not covered in these conditions will be decided at the discretion of the tournament committee.
- Prize funds will be adjusted to reflect entries on the day.
- Nominations will be accepted via the NSW RBT Facebook Page only.
- A non-refundable deposit will be required to secure your place in your chosen squad.
- Puff balls/powders must be contained in sealable plastic bags
- Check in times for all squads and finals stages will be strictly adhered to. In the case of finals stages, bowlers who have not had themselves marked as present to the check in counter by the advertised check in close time will be replaced by the next available reserve.
