OVERVIEW

This is a TBA accredited event and all rules and regulations will apply. All participants are required to be current TBA members. Any matter not covered in this entry form will be at the discretion of the tournament directors and NSW Regional Bowling Tour committee.

This is both a scratch (open division) and handicap (graded division) event. Bowlers may only nominate for one division throughout the event. A graded bowler is defined as a bowler has an average equal to or below 189 as at 30 April 2025 OR a bowler who has participated in any other NSW RBT graded division during 2025. Graded bowlers will need to provide evidence of their highest average over 18 or more games as at 30 April 2025, this will be used to determine their handicap based on 90% of 200 or 10 pins above the highest entering average (whichever is higher). The tournament directors have the right to regrade any bowler's average where this is deemed necessary.

The open entry fee and graded entry fee each include 2 squads, all subsequent re-entries include 1 squad. Pinfall will drop at the end of each stage.

FORMAT

Qualifying – best 2 x 4 game squads, for a total of 8 qualifying games, re-entries will be permitted. During all qualifying squads bowlers will move lanes after 2 games.

Open bowlers will progress based on pinfall, while Graded bowlers will progress based on pinfall plus handicap.

Following the completion of all qualifying squads, the top 6 open bowlers and the top 3 graded bowlers will progress directly to stage 3. The next 20 open bowlers (7th to 26th) and the next 12 graded bowlers (4th to 15th) will progress to stage 2.

Stage 2 – Check in closes for all bowlers (including those progressing straight to stage 3) at 8:30am. Bowlers 7 through to 26 in open and 4 through to 15 in graded will complete a further 4 games, moving lanes after each game, at the completion of these 4 games the top 9 open bowlers and top 6 graded bowlers will progress to stage 3.

Stage 3 – Lanes will be oiled again ahead of this stage. The remaining 15 open bowlers and 9 graded bowlers will complete a further 4 games, moving lanes after each game, At the completion of stage 3, the top 4 bowlers in both open and graded divisions will progress to the semi finals.

Semi final – 1 game match with seed 1 playing seed 4 and seed 2 playing seed 3. The winner of each match (including handicap for graded) will progress to the final. The eliminated bowlers will be awarded equal 3rd place.

Final – 1 game match with the highest game (including handicap for graded) being the 2025 Windsor Open Champions.

TIES

Ties for the final qualifying position will be broken by a bowlers highest game (including handicap for graded) from their 8 game qualifying total. Ties to progress during stage 2 and stage 3 will be broken by highest last game. Any tie for a bowler to progress that is unable to be by highest last game or for any tie in the semi final and final rounds will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll off (including one tenth of handicap applied per frame for graded).

Ties for any position outside of the top 4 will have prizes combined and then divided evenly between the tied bowlers.

Check in closes 15 minutes prior to the times listed above. Each squad will be limited to the number listed in brackets above. A non-refundable and non-transferable deposit of \$50 will be required to secure your first entry, a further \$50 will be required for EACH re-entry squad nominated.
