Lyndon Quinlivan Masters 2026

Tournament Rules & Overview

The 2026 Lyndon Quinlivan Masters is a TBA accredited event, and all TBA rules and regulations will apply, and all bowlers are required to be current TBA members. All NSW Regional Bowling Tour rules will also apply throughout the event. Any matters not covered will be resolved at the discretion of the tournament director.

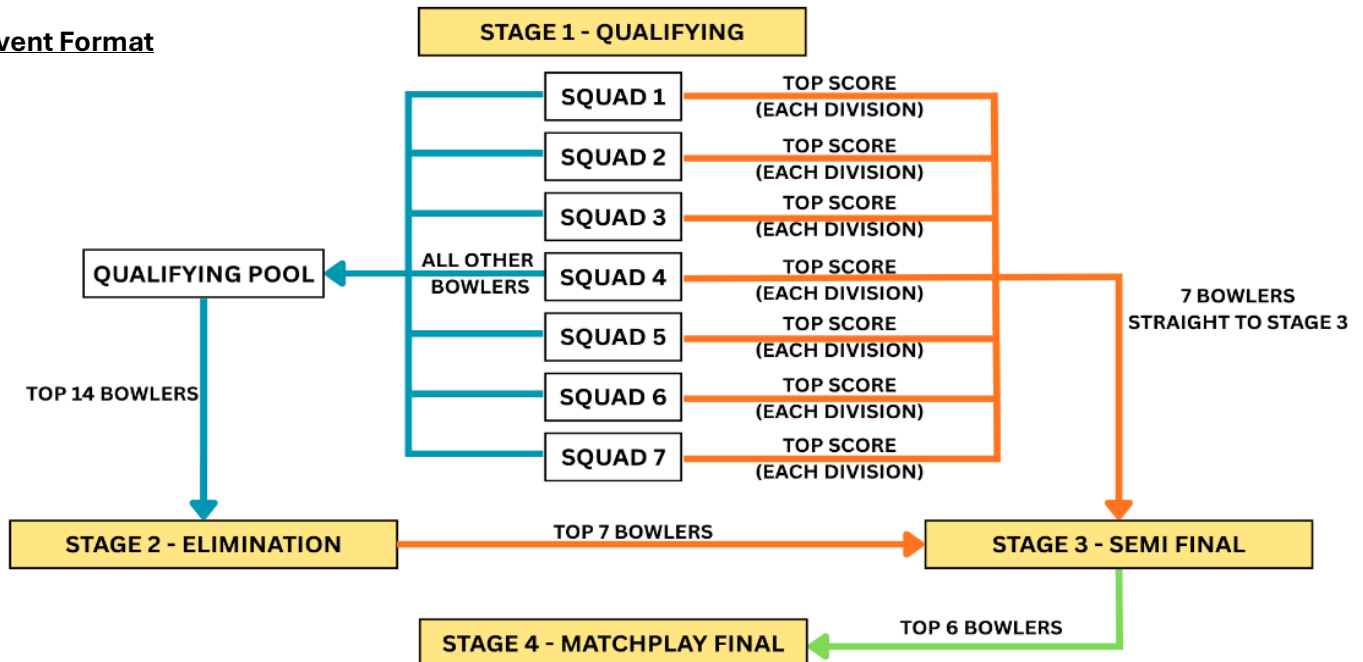
This event will consist of an open and graded division; bowlers must nominate their preferred division when submitting their entry. The open division will use scratch scores only; no handicaps or bonus pins will be awarded to any open division bowlers. The graded division will use 90% of 210 to determine handicaps and is open to all bowlers with an average below 190 as of 31st December 2025, or any bowler who has participated in any other NSW Regional Tour graded event during 2026. Graded bowlers must be able to provide evidence of their highest average over 18 games as of 30th June 2026 (a current average can be used in the case that a bowler does not have an established average at the cut off date). The tournament director has the right to re-grade any bowler's average where deemed necessary.

Entries will be opened approximately 6 weeks prior to the event, through an announcement on the NSW Regional Tour Facebook page. To enter, a comment can be placed on the official post for the event with the bowler's name, division, and preferred squad, or alternatively entries can be accepted directly in the centre. Entries will continue to be accepted while squads have availability up to 30 minutes prior to the final squad. A non-refundable deposit of \$50 will be required to secure entries, with balance to be paid by Friday 4th September.

Surface adjustments can not be made to bowling balls during a session of play throughout this event. During this event a session of play is considered to be all squads and stages. This event will follow the TBA ruling for allowed equipment consistent with ranked events and IBF restrictions on slow oil absorbing balls, more information can be found on the TBA and NSW Regional Tour websites. Bowling balls will be randomly examined, and hardness testing will be carried out throughout the event.

Oil Pattern will be NSW Tour 1 (42).

Event Format



Stage 1 (Qualifying):

Check-in closes 15 minutes before each squad. Bowlers will bowl 7 games in one appearance, changing lanes each game (odd lanes will move left 1 pair, even lanes will move right 1 pair). The highest scoring open and graded bowler from each qualifying squad will proceed straight to Stage 3 (7 bowlers from each division total). All other bowlers will be placed in to the qualifying pool, where the 14 highest placing bowlers in each division will continue to Stage 2. Pinfall will not carry over, and requalifying will not be allowed. In the event of a tie, the highest last game will be used to break the tie.

Stage 2 (Elimination):

Check-in closes at 8:00 am, Sunday 13th. The 14 qualifying bowlers in both divisions will bowl 4 games, moving one pair of lanes after each game. At the conclusion of the 4 games, the top 7 bowlers in each division (including handicap for graded bowlers) will proceed to Stage 3. In the event of a tie, the highest last game will be used to break the tie. Pinfall will not carry over to Stage 3.

Stage 3 (Semi Final):

After lane maintenance, the top 7 bowlers from Stage 1 (check in for Stage 1 bowlers closes at 9:30 am), and the top 7 bowlers from Stage 2 in each division will bowl a further 4 games, changing 1 pair of lanes each game. Once all games are completed, the top 6 bowlers in each division will qualify for the Final stage. If there is a tie for 6th place, the highest last game will be used to break the tie. Any other ties will equally share positions and prizes. Pinfall will not carry over to Stage 4.

Stage 4 (Match-Play Final):

The top 6 bowlers in each division will play off in a match-play final, with each head-to-head win to grant a bonus of 20 pins per game (pins will be shared in any drawn match). At the conclusion of the 5 games, final pinfall including any relevant handicap and bonuses will decide all final placings. In the event of a tie for 1st place, a 1 game roll-off will be played to break the tie. Any other ties will equally share positions and prizes awarded.

Qualifying Squads

The tournament committee asks that all local bowlers and those from neighbouring towns (Shepparton, Wangaratta, Wagga Wagga, ect) participate in the first weekend. Visiting bowlers from outside these areas will be given priority in squad selection after the first weekend. All squads will be limited to 28 bowlers and eligible for both open and graded bowlers.

- Squad 5 - 8 am, check in closes 7:45 am.
- Squad 6 - 12 pm, check in closes 11:45 am.
- Squad 7 – 4pm, check in closes 3.45pm

Seniors Division:

The top 4 graded division seniors from the Qualifying Pool that did not progress to any further stage will play in a 3-game sprint. Highest pinfall after the 3 games will be declared the winner and receive a \$200 pro shop voucher thanks to **Double 77**. Runner up will receive \$150 pro shop voucher, and 3rd/4th position bowlers will receive \$100 pro shop vouchers each. Check in closes 11:30 am Sunday 13th, format subject to change based on entries received.

Recruiter Doubles Side Pot

Bowlers may nominate to enter the Recruiter Doubles Side Pot. This side event is optional to enter, and bowlers may have multiple entries with different doubles partners. Each bowler's qualifying scores from *Stage 1* will be combined, with the highest scores in each division of Open, Graded, & Mixed (1 open and 1 graded bowler) winning a share of the side pots. Entry fee of \$20 per team, with all funds collected from this entry fee will be paid back to the winners. The size of each side pot depends on entries in that division; the prize money will not be mixed. Prize payout: 1st 30%, 2nd 25%, 3rd 20%, 4th 15%, 5th 10%.

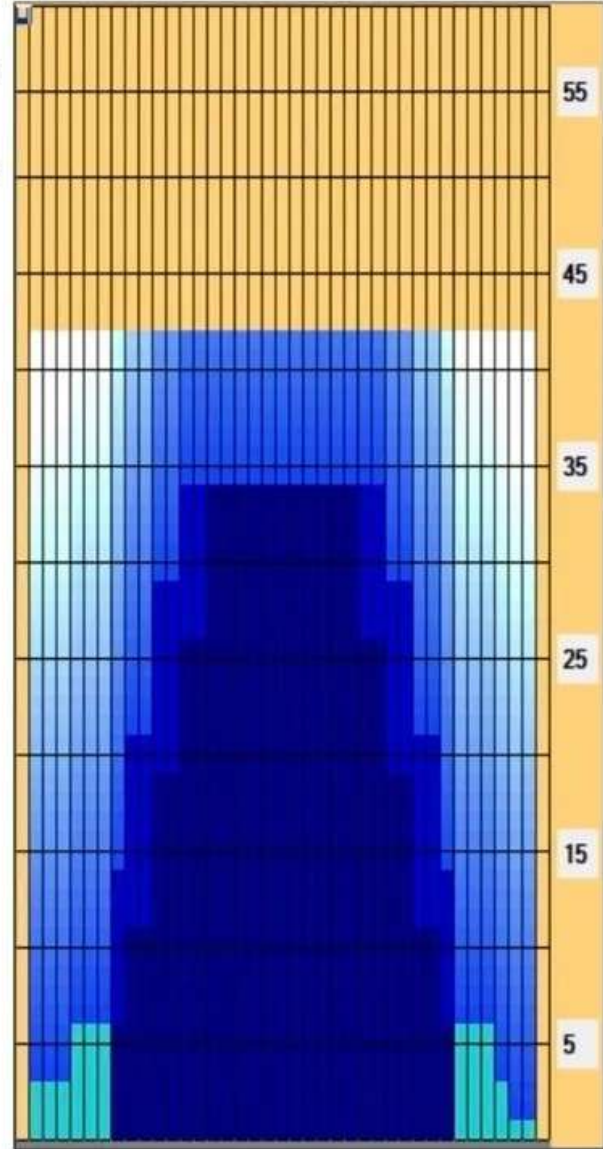
