Qualifying Format and Check-In Times:

Friday 21st March 2025

Squad A – Check In by 5pm (Limited to 20 Spots)

Squad A will bowl 8 Games of qualifying. After every 2 game block players will move 1 pair of lanes. Odd lanes to the left and even lanes to the right.

Saturday 22nd March 2025

Squad B – Check In by 8:15am (Limited to 44 Spots)

Squad B will bowl 8 Games of qualifying. After every 2 game block players will move 1 pair of lanes. Odd lanes to the left and even lanes to the right.

Saturday 22nd March 2025

Squad C – Check In by 12:30pm (Limited to 44 Spots)

Squad C will bowl 8 Games of qualifying. After every 2 game block players will move 1 pair of lanes. Odd lanes to the left and even lanes to the right.

OPEN RESULTS:

Top 22 Bowlers based on total pinfall after Squads A,B and C will progress to the open final.

GRADED RESULTS:

Top 10 Bowlers based on total pinfall including handicap after Squads A,B and C will progress to the graded final.



Open/Graded Final Format and Check-In Time:

Final – Sunday 23rd March 2025

Check-In by 8:15am

All previous pinfall is dropped, and players will now bowl 8 games. After every game players will move 1 pair of lanes. Odd lanes to the left and even lanes to the right.

Open Finalists - The highest pinfall after the 8 games will be declared the Open Zambo winner.

Graded Finalists - The highest pinfall with handicap after the 8 games will be declared the Graded Zambo winner.

Tournament Conditions:

- This is a singles tournament consisting of Open (scratch) & Graded (handicapped) divisions. This is a TBA accredited event and all rules and regulations will govern this event.
- All participants are required to be current 2025 TBA members. Any matter not cover in this entry form will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
- This event will be run in accordance with any current restrictions imposed within NSW, this includes no physical contact including high fives or handshakes.
- In event of a tie-on Saturday Open for 22nd position the players Highest last Game will take 22nd place.
- In event of a tie-on Sunday Open (for 1st place) there will be a 1 game roll off in event of a tie at the end of this game 9th & 10th frame will be re-bowled until we have a winner
- In event of a tie for 10th place for Graded we will take players highest last game to determine 10th place
- The Graded Division is handicapped @100% of 200. Bowlers with an average equal or below 189 as at 28/02/2025 over a minimum of 18 games. Proof of average will be required.

RULE 209 SLOW BOWLING from TBA Rule Book

Players preparing to step on the approach and deliver a ball shall have the following rights and obligations

- a) They may claim right of way only over a player moving to the approach or preparing to bowl on the lane immediately to their left.
- b) They shall yield to a player moving to the approach or preparing to bowl on the lane immediately to their right.
- c) Players shall be ready to bowl when it is their turn and shall not delay the start of their approach or delivery if the lane immediately adjacent to them on both the right and left are clear.
- d) A player is given 30 seconds from the moment the previous bowler steps down from the approach to the time the ball leaves the hand of the bowler

Tournament Officials may use stop watches to randomly check the timing of the bowlers in their delivery.

e) If a player does not observe the procedures outlined in a) to d) above it shall be construed as slow bowling. A player failing to observe these procedures shall be warned by an authorized tournament official as follows:

- i) A verbal warning will be given (no penalty)

- ii) A yellow card for the second offence (no penalty)

- iii) A red card for the third and each succeeding offence in any block of games. The penalty shall be a zero-pin fall for the frame. A block of games is as defined in that particular competition and all remaining games of match play in a day.

f) For interpretation of the enforcement of this rule, Tournament Officials shall specifically monitor any player or team that gets more than four frames behind the leader in a singles, doubles or master event; or more than two frames behind in trios or team, not counting the end pairs of lanes. In Baker format competition the same rule applies as for the singles event.

g) Whenever there is any question concerning the enforcement of this rule the Tournament Director shall make the final decision.

RULE 212 SMOKING from TBA Rule Book

TBA recommends that smoking by participants in League be prohibited whilst the league is competing. In tournaments, smoking and the use of any tobacco products including synthetic cigarettes or e-cigarettes is prohibited by a participant during any squad/round/matchplay from the allocated time including the warm-up until the last ball is bowled by them, regardless of whether lanes are changed in that bowling session or not.
