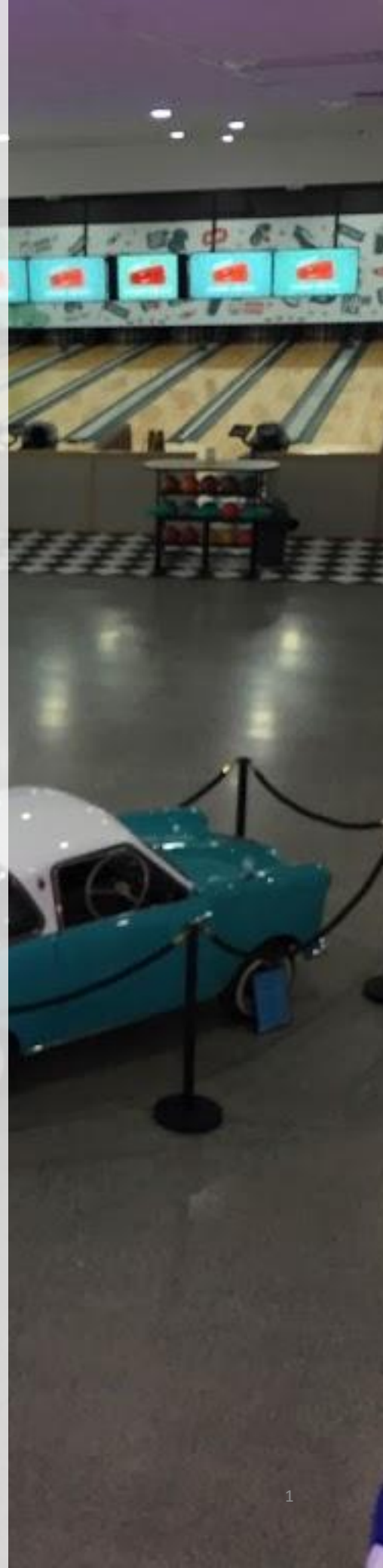

Qualifying Format and Check-In Times:

Saturday 21st March 2026

Squad A – Check In by 8:15am (Limited to 44 Spots)

Squad B – Check In by 12:30pm (Limited to 40 Spots)

Each squad will bowl 8 Games of qualifying. After every 2 game block players will move 1 pair of lanes. Odd lanes to the left and even lanes to the right.

OPEN RESULTS:

Top 22 Bowlers based on total pinfall after Squads A and B will progress to the open final.

GRADED RESULTS:

Top 10 Bowlers based on total pinfall including handicap after Squads A and B will progress to the graded final.

Open/Graded Final Format and Check-In Time:

Final – Sunday 22nd March 2026

Check-In by 8:15am – If you miss check-in the next bowler based on qualifying will be offered the spot.

All previous pinfall will carry-over and players will now bowl 8 more games. After every game, players will move 1 pair of lanes. Odd lanes to the left and even lanes to the right.

Open Finalists - The highest pinfall at the conclusion of the 8 games will be declared the Open Zambo winner.

Graded Finalists - The highest pinfall with handicap at the conclusion of the 8 games will be declared the Graded Zambo winner.

2026 Tournament Conditions:

- This is a singles tournament consisting of Open (scratch) & Graded (handicapped) divisions. This is a TBA accredited event and all rules and regulations will govern this event.
- All participants are required to be current 2026 TBA members. Any matter not cover in this entry form will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
- In event of a tie-on Saturday Open for 22nd position the players Highest last Game will take 22nd place. If the highest last game is also the same, we will go back to the previous game until the tie is broken.
- In event of a tie-on Sunday Open (for 1st place) there will be a 1 game roll off. In event of a tie at the end of this game 9th & 10th frame will be re-bowled until we have a winner
- In event of a tie for 10th place for Graded we will take players highest last game including handicap to determine 10th place
- In event of a tie-on Sunday Graded (for 1st place) there will be a 1 game roll off including handicap. In event of a tie at the end of this game a 9th & 10th frame rolloff will be bowled/re-bowled until we have a winner. During the 9th and 10th Rolloff 1/10th of the bowlers handicap will be included per frame.
- The Graded Division is handicapped @100% of 200. Bowlers with an average equal or below 189 as at 31/12/2025 over a minimum of 18 games. Proof of average will be required. A current average can be used in the case that a bowler does not have an established average as of the cut-off date. The Tournament Director reserves the right to regrade any bowlers average where this is deemed necessary.
- Dress Code – Competitors are required to dress in appropriate and neatly presented attire suitable for bowling. Jeans, tights, trackpants, singlets, offensive slogans and excessively torn or ill-fitting clothing will not be permitted.
- Urethane Ban – Urethane bowling balls (including 78D and Microcell Polymer) will not be permitted for use throughout the 2026 NSW regional bowling tour. Pre-exempt urethane cover “spare balls” will be approved and listed on the NSW Regional tour website, for the purpose of spare shooting (must be thrown on second shots). This list will include known urethane spare balls (e.g. Storm Mix, Motiv Propel). Balls can be added to this list on request.
- Equipment Surface Adjustments – No surface adjustments (e.g. cleaner, sanding) will be allowed to bowling balls during each session. Surface adjustments can only be made during practice and again once the session is completed. Each Session is defined as:
 - Qualifying – 8 Games
 - Finals – 8 Games

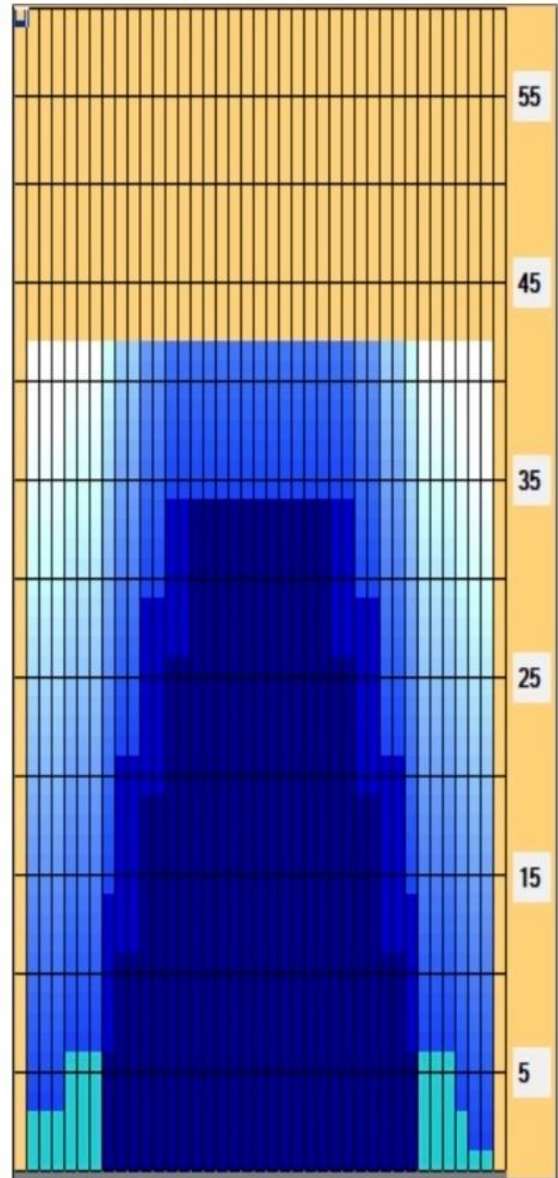

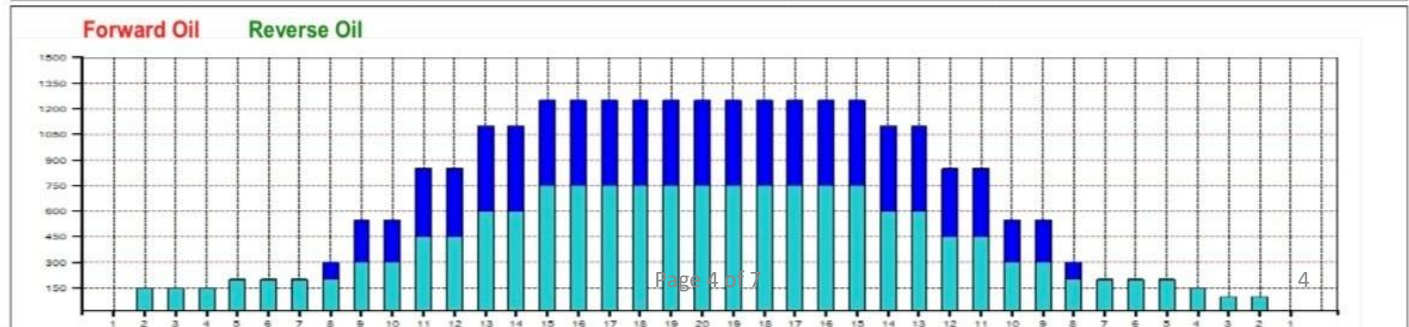

RULE 209 SLOW BOWLING from TBA Rule Book

Players preparing to step on the approach and deliver a ball shall have the following rights and obligations

- a) They may claim right of way only over a player moving to the approach or preparing to bowl on the lane immediately to their left.
- b) They shall yield to a player moving to the approach or preparing to bowl on the lane immediately to their right.
- c) Players shall be ready to bowl when it is their turn and shall not delay the start of their approach or delivery if the lane immediately adjacent to them on both the right and left are clear.
- d) A player is given 30 seconds from the moment the previous bowler steps down from the approach to the time the ball leaves the hand of the bowler

Tournament Officials may use stop watches to randomly check the timing of the bowlers in their delivery.

e) If a player does not observe the procedures outlined in a) to d) above it shall be construed as slow bowling. A player failing to observe these procedures shall be warned by an authorized tournament official as follows:

- i) A verbal warning will be given (no penalty)
- ii) A yellow card for the second offence (no penalty)

iii) A red card for the third and each succeeding offence in any block of games. The penalty shall be a zero-pin fall for the frame. A block of games is as defined in that particular competition and all remaining games of match play in a day.

f) For interpretation of the enforcement of this rule, Tournament Officials shall specifically monitor any player or team that gets more than four frames behind the leader in a singles, doubles or master event; or more than two frames behind in trios or team, not counting the end pairs of lanes. In Baker format competition the same rule applies as for the singles event.

g) Whenever there is any question concerning the enforcement of this rule the Tournament Director shall make the final decision.

RULE 212 SMOKING from TBA Rule Book

TBA recommends that smoking by participants in League be prohibited whilst the league is competing. In tournaments, smoking and the use of any tobacco products including synthetic cigarettes or e-cigarettes is prohibited by a participant during any squad/round/matchplay from the allocated time including the warm-up until the last ball is bowled by them, regardless of whether lanes are changed in that bowling session or not.
