- 1. When on the court, you follow values that Northern Bombers uphold to ensure a fair game for all.
 - a. These include: Integrity, Respect, Responsibility-Fairness and Safety. These are in addition to the list of general Northern Bombers codes of behaviour (in this list) and those behaviours condoned by ENA(Elizabeth Netball Association).
- 2. Fully comply with the child safety code of conduct.
- 3. Participate because you can enjoy it, not just to please parents and coaches.
- 4. Play by the rules.
- 5. Participate fairly and safely.
- 6. Abide by decisions without argument and bad behaviour
- 7. Only Captains have the right to approach an umpire during intervals or after the game on clarifications for any rule.
- 8. Players, Coaches approach the umpires in a courteous and polite way.
- 9. Co-operate with your coaches and other players.
- 10. Treat all players as how you would like to be treated.
- 11. Applaud all good play of your own team and opponents.
- 12.Be a responsible team member.
- 13. Always on time.
- 14. Encourage and assist all players.
- 15. Try to attend all training sessions.
- 16. Ensure you always bring the appropriate uniform and equipment to all training and games
- 17.Do not engage in practices that would effect your sporting performance on the court
 - (ie: alcohol, tabacco, drug use)
- 18. Respect and acknowledge the contribution of those who create the opportunity for you to play including volunteers (Scorers, coaches, timekeepers, team managers, administrators, and umpires)
- 19. When wearing the bombers uniform you are representing the club and should maintain a high standard of Respect and Integrity at all times.
- 20. No death threats, encouragement of suicide, encouragement of eating disorders or any other disorders such as mental health issues. Should this code be broken you will be asked to leave the club immediately (Kicked out of club). Police involvement maybe implemented without hesitation

- 21. Bombers will not stand for any kind of BULLYING in anyway shape or form.
- 22. Once your child(ren) has left the court for anything (ie: any breaks and end of games). It becomes the parents responsibility to look after them (Club will not be held viable for any bad behaviour away from the game they are playing)
- 23. All fee's must be paid in a 6 week time frame, unless you have worked out a payment plan with our treasurer and are keeping to it. If You choose to not stick to it, you will not be able to take court or take court until all outstanding monies owed to the club are paid for.
- 24. It is your responsibility to look after your child(ren) if they choose to play at the playground or anywhere out at ENA. Should any incident occur, this is and will be ENA'S responsibility and Not the clubs
- 25. A \$35.00 administration fee will be charged to any player who decides not to play once registered in a team with ENA.
- 26. <u>If any player decides to leave once the season has began,</u> then full fee's will be charged (Subject to Executive Committee decision)
