

Treasure Coast Senior Softball Board of Directors May meeting minutes:

The first meeting of the **Treasure Coast Senior Softball Association's** 2020-21 Board of Directors met at Langford Park on May 21, 2020. The meeting was called to order by **Tim Rocklein**. Present were Bill Schmidt, Bob Ernst, Joe Faggione, and Tim, and joining the group via telephone was Dave Messner.

The first order of business was to elect the 2020-21 board officers. The results:

- President – Dave
- Vice President – Tim
- Treasurer – Joe
- Secretary – Bill
- Trustee - Bob

The TCSSA 2019-20 **financial books** were closed at the end of our fiscal year: 4/31/2020. Our closing balance was **\$6,503.03**. There are two items from the 2020 season that still need to be paid for, i.e., the league championship trophy and the league championship jackets.

Next, the Board unanimously voted to allow **all** TCSSA members (year-around residents and all others who are here for a shorter period of time) to seek to be a team manager for the 2021 season. The Board will ultimately make the final decision on who will manage. By July, we will issue a list of the characteristics we will be looking for in a manager.

The Board will have monthly meetings through the end of 2020.

Joe and Dave put together Covid-19 guidelines for the safety of our members when we return to playing softball at Langford:

1. Players will practice appropriate social distancing (a minimum of 10 feet apart) when sitting in the stands or standing outside of the fenced playing area and during batting practice. ***The dugouts will not be used, and players are prohibited from sitting or standing in them.***
2. Protective masks will be worn near other players and spectators.
3. Hand sanitizers will be provided on both the home and visitors' sides of the field. Players not wearing gloves are encouraged to use the sanitizer between innings.
4. The game balls will be sanitized between innings and at times during the game when possible.
5. Players will be responsible for removing their bat from the field of play after each at-bat. If a player reaches base, his bat will be put aside. After the inning, the owner of the bat will be expected to remove it from the field of play. ***Bats will not be shared.***

6. Any player repeatedly coughing or showing signs of a cold will be asked to leave the park.
