How to Format a USB ThumbDrive to FAT32 Mac Operating Systems

*Note: Formatting or reformatting any USB drive will effectively delete all its contents. It is advisable to first backup anything you don't wish to lose. Or to avoid confusion, use a brand new dedicated drive.

- Prepare a fresh USB thumb-drive, SSD or HD with 1GB of available storage space formatted FAT32. Performing a FAT32 format using a macOS computer can be a bit tricky. Here's how to do it.
- 2. Connect the drive to your computer and launch the Disc Utility. (Disc utility can be found by searching using the magnifying glass icon at the top right.
- 3. In the Disk Utility left column, select the drive.
- 4. Select Erase.
- 5. Select Format. Then select MS-DOS (FAT).
- 6. Select Scheme. Then select Master Boot Record.
- Click Erase. The utility will now format the drive properly for use with TouchMix. Exit the Disk Utility when you are done.
