How to Format a USB Drive to FAT32

Windows Operating Systems

*Note: Formatting or reformatting any USB drive will effectively delete all its contents. It is advisable to first backup anything you don't wish to lose. Or to avoid confusion, use a brand new dedicated drive.

- 1. Connect the USB storage device to the computer.
- 2. In the Computer or This PC window, right-click the drive icon in which the USB device appears.
- 3. From the menu, click Format...
- In the Format device name (drive letter) window, under File system, click the drop-down arrow, select FAT32
 or NTFS. Then click Start.
- 5. At the WARNING... message, select OK to continue.
- 6. At the Format Complete message, click OK.
- 7. At the Format device name (drive letter) window, click Close.
- 8. In the top-right corner of the Computer or This PC window, click the X to close the window.

How to Format USB Drive Using the QSC TouchMix-8/16

- 1. Insert USB drive into available USB port on rear of TouchMix-8/16.
- 2. Press "Menu" button.
- 3. Under the Setup section, touch "Mixer Setup".
- 4. Touch "Format USB Drive".
- 5. A dialog box appears. Touch "Format" to proceed.
- 6. The procedure begins, and a series of Warning messages appears in successive dialog boxes. Read the messages, but no need to press anything until the final message displays: "USB Drive successfully formatted".
- 7. Touch "OK"

Your drive is now successfully formatted to FAT32 and ready for TouchMix use.
