Primary Functions

- Identify Companies in Most Hazardous Positions
- Make Rescue Plans to Support Their Escape
- Position at Best Access to Those in Hazardous Positions
- Stage Equipment for Deployment, Match to Construction and Operation
- Monitor Crew Location, Progress and Operations
- Refresh and Revise Rescue Plan Throughout Incident

Operational Considerations

Secondary Exits for all crews operating	Rescue Plans Developed & Reviewed

Additional RIT Needed	Consult with ISO & OPERATIONS
Air Management	Manage crew distance from alternate exit points

Primary Tasks

- Respond to any MAYDAY call
- Assess the need for ground ladders
- Assemble and maintain RIT equipment at entry point location
- Monitor radio and maintain contact with IC
- Assess where crews are working and assignment
- Obtain reports from Operations and ISO

Stage equipment at primary access entry point

Secondary Tasks

- Do not enter the hot zone
- Secure utilities
- Perform horizontal ventilation
- Open rear of structure
- Unblock potential areas of egress
- Place ladders for egress/ access to structure

Any actions taken by RIT must be reported to Command

Response to MAYDAY

- Verify to ISO or IC on fireground channel entry location and PAR
- Bring equipment for rescue and victim access
- Progress to ISO or IC as needed (RITO responsibility)
- Locate, assess & remove trapped firefighter
