☐ Place marker buoy at last scene point
Request status and numbers of responding divers, request additional as needed
☐ Determine need for specialty divers or Tech (Ice, Swift water, TRT team)
Determine forecasted weather conditions
Evaluate underwater conditions
Determine current in area of incident, and how it will affect body movement
Decide on which patterns will be used in search operations
Request from command appropriate resources if dive becomes long term.
