Art for-Charity is a nonprofit community art initiative created by For-Charity Foundation. The project began with the idea of using a modern video vending machine to dispense high-quality, affordable artwork created by talented local artists.

The machine features collectible ACEO cards—Artist Cards, Editions and Originals—along with limited-edition prints, artist collections, creative kits, journals, and small products from the **Art Makes You Happy** line.

Local artists donate artwork and participate in a growing creative collaboration. Their work gives community members an affordable way to collect art while supporting meaningful local causes.

Since beginning operations, the project has welcomed artists, Arts Council members, volunteers, families, and community supporters. It has also inspired new partnerships, product ideas, artist collections, and opportunities for community art activities.
