Advanced Sedation

Provided by Dr Justin Roberts (Consultant Anaesthetist), a combination of sedatives used to deliver moderate sedation for complex treatments. It allows for safe, effective sedation for longer visits



Inhalation Sedation

Provided by Dr Shilpa Shah (Dentist), this is a gentle, quick-acting method. It helps mildly anxious adults and children feel calm, improving cooperation and allowing for a quick recovery



Intranasal Sedation

A sedative is sprayed into the nose, making the patient relaxed during treatment. It is a key technique for those with Learning Disabilities, Autism, or Severe Needle Phobia who struggle to accept cannulation whilst alert



Oral Sedation

This involves having a sedative drink in the surgery to feel relaxed. It is useful for individuals who cannot tolerate injections whilst awake or those who commonly experience fainting at the thought of a needle
