


Episode 104 –Chips & Strips Easy Baby Quilt

Episode 104 – Chips & Strips Easy Baby Quilt

This pattern is easily ranked as a beginner pattern and can be adapted to any size by adjusting the number of blocks used. As demonstrated measures 40 x 40” using 25 blocks, without borders. Using a variety of fabrics with a common background color and four blocks bring this altogether – make it scrappy and it will have a whole new look.




BLOCK A:

Quantity to make: 9 Unfinished Size 8.5 x 8.5”

Each block requires

2 @ 4.5 x 2.5” Dark (High Contrast) Fabric

6 @ 4.5 x 2.5” Light Color (Low Volume) Fabric




BLOCK B:

Quantity to make: 4 Unfinished size 8.5x 8.5”

Each block requires

2 @ 4.5 x 2.5” Dark (High Contrast, shown Green/Blue) Fabric

6 @ 2.5 x 2.5” Dark (High Contrast shown in Black) Fabric




BLOCK C:

Quantity to make: 4 Unfinished size 8.5x 8.5”

Each block requires

2 @ 8.5 x 2.5” OR 4 @ 4.5 x 2.5” Dark (High Contrast, shown Green/Blue) Fabric

2 @ 8.5 x 2.5” OR 4 @ 4.5 x 2.5” Light/Low Volume Fabric



BLOCK D:


Quantity to make: 8 Unfinished size 8.5x 8.5”

Each block requires

2 @ 8.5 x 2.5” OR 4 @ 4.5 x 2.5” Dark (High Contrast, shown Green/Blue) Fabric

1 @ 8.5 x 2.5” OR 2 @ 4.5 x 2.5: Dark (Shown in Black) Fabric

1 @ 8.5 x 2.5” OR 2 @ 4.5 x 2.5” Light/Low Volume Fabric
