Use as one large block and surround with an outer border of your choosing or make multiple blocks for a larger quilt. The information here is for one block as demonstrated in the YouTube video. Size approx. 31.5" x 31.5"





# **Blocks:**

# Step One

Quantity Required to Make 9:


9 -patch made using 2" squares 4 light and 5 dark fabrics (brown)



# Step 2:

Quantity Required to Make 12

3 stack (rail fence) using 4.5" x 2" strips in each block use 2 light and 1 dark brown fabric







#### Step 3:

Quantity Required to Make 8

Each block uses 2" squares in 3 light fabric and 3 dark (brown) fabric



#### Step 4:

Quantity Required to Make 4 each block uses: 3.5 x 3.5" light fabric squares 2 x 5" dark (black) fabric 2 x 3.5" dark (black) fabric



inside corners

Total: 4

Inches: 4.5 x 4.5

### Step 5:

Quantity Required to Make 12

3 stack (rail fence) using 4.5" x 2" strips in each block use 2 light and 1 dark (black) fabric



3 stack potato chip

Total: 12

Inches: 4.5 x 4.5





# Step 6:

Quantity Required to Make 4: Each of these units uses 3.5 x 5" dark fabric (brown) 2 @ 2 x 3.5" (black) 1 @ 2 x 8" (black)
