



Bulletin Summary of St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church Council Meeting July 16, 2025, 7:00 PM.

Welcome All - Devotions—Marsha gave the devotions.

- July agenda was approved along June minutes
- Expressions of Gratitude and Need --
 - O Thank you to all who attended, planned, helped with the July 5th worship. Lots of positive comments about the service and the singing. People loved singing the patriotic, familiar hymns. The message helped us remember and be grateful.
 - o If you wish to register your children early for VBS, please come into the office and you may do that.
 - o Big THANK YOU to Dennis and Brenda Smith you silently come to the church and water plants, flowers, trim, pull weeds, and generally do much outside work. We get to enjoy the beauty.
- Peggy-reported on June financials—Income was \$28,680.90. Expenditures were \$28,367.26 with monthly balance of \$313.64. Total loss for the year of (\$23,697/01). Financials were approved for June.
- Brett asked that council consider opening a PayPal account. He sent an email writing reasons why he thought this should be considered. After reading the letter, talking some of the pros and cons, a vote was called. The motion did not pass mainly because we already have a Venmo account. Carol was to notify Brett.
- Pastors report—Pastors Jim/Kathleen—Pastors submitted a report. They will call Pastor Brian Johnson, inquiring if the First Presbyterian is interested in attending and help plan a joint service on August 31st, Labor Day Weekend. Pastor will be off a few days to be with cousin in Florida. Reviewed a letter from Bishop Scott, NE Synod, about an "outside" source that is being sent to Lutheran congregations asking that the congregation contact them for help on property, governing documents, and beliefs. It appears to be similar to a scam. NE councils, and congregations are be asked to be aware. Discussed how to support flood victims and churches in Texas. Video showing the EICA at work in Keer County, Texas was shared. LWR -disaster fund is funneling money there. It was suggested we use the video during the services, encourage members to donate to St. Johns, with memo choosing donated money be sent to the ELCA Disaster Fund, Texas. Council treasurer was asked to apply to Benefaction for matching funds up to \$2500. Motion made and unanimously carried that St. John's does that. Addition discussion was about Thrivent Funds.
- Ministry Committee reports--Teams should meet quarterly/monthly.
 - Visitation report/member care—JoAnn, Brian, Doug- Time and Talent sheet.
 Check lists are slowly still coming in. Cindy is compiling. Each group needs to check if everyone has been contacted.
 - Benefaction-Brenda Smith, Adam report, Chairman-John Skogstoe
 — Next meeting will be August 12, 2025.
 Applications due 8-1-25.
 - Legacy—Doug- contact Tyler at Insight Financial and asked to be included in Benefaction presentation and some time be given just to Legacy for questions. Legacy will need just a few minutes.
 - Mission Life—JoAnn— Peanut Butter Pyramid for local food pantry. Part of VBS. Next Meeting is August 6, 2025 @ 12:30pm—Planning for God's Work meal. All members are to watch for plans and participate by eating and sharing their hands for an hour on September 7th—God's Work-Our Hands. Also, if interested order a yellow T-shirt through the office.
 - Fellowship -Outreach--Chairman –Kristy Booras—Marsha reported. BBQ on Sept 13th after the 5pm service. Watch for details. Organizing brochures on August, September, October Activities that will include Faith Fest, Rally Day, Labor Day, God's Work-Our Hands, and Trunk or Treat, etc.
 - Altar Guild -Laurie Simonsen.
 - Christian Ed- Chairman of SS—Peggy reports—Rally Day is August 23-24th. Plans are being discussed.
 Watch for decision, involvement and times.

- Property-Lon report— Lon is chair- The projection problem has been solved for most likely a few years giving time to make some future plans. Property to purchase 2 additional projector bulbs. (They are expensive.)
 - Insurance increase by \$400+ per month. After discussion on current insurance deductible amount (\$10,000), it was decided to raise deductible to \$20,000—making our current insurance payment about the same as we are paying now. Motion made and unanimously carried.
- Stewardship--Doug Holmberg- Brian-ministry moments -Asked if they can get a couple clips during the VBS.
- o Rebekah Circle—Carol--report-July eating out/come and enjoy
- o Memorial-Carol W.—Nancy S, chair- Carol reporting—Meeting as needed. If something is needed get easy application in office, fill out, return to office.
- Scholarship committee-Lisa, chair, Peggy, reports-No TAG requests as yet. Suggestion—if no use, try music
 majors at the college. Will contact Lisa and Benefaction. Possibly using money to pay tuition for scholarship
 to Northeast. A new plan might need to be written and approved.
- o Quilts—met and are working. Have made 45 quilts. Goal is to exceed 60 quilts. One is featured because it will be sold at Camp Carol Joy.
- o Faith Fest-Adam, report—Dates—Friday, August 15th 5pm-10pm. How are we connecting this to our church and our congregation is still being discussed.
- Media Ministry Team—John S. chair.—reporting is Brian. Have a team of volunteers. They are enthused and will start to work soon.
- Music/Worship team— John, Penny, Linda, Steve, Jill, Diane H. Brian. Brian reports—Planning
 Presbyterian and St. John's service. Will be coffee hour before and after. Also, a 5pm Saturday service.
- Personnel/staff relations--quarterly report-Diana,--visited with Pastors about their questions, hopes, needs as they work at St. John's. Both feel we need to plan more for youth.
