

Subject: Report of Progress with the Call Process

November, 2024

May, 2024—Accepted the resignation of previous pastor.

May, 2024—Notified Bishop Scott, of NE Synod of the resignation.

May 19<sup>th,</sup> 2024—Pastor Greg Berger, from Synod, met with previous pastor and council. Pastor Greg conducted exit report. Previous pastor left for vacation until June 1<sup>st</sup> and found supply pastors until then.

Council continued the assignment until Sept 1.

June, 2024—Synod recommended names to contact for supply as well as for interim. Council contacted Pastor Jim/Kathleen in June to be supply pastors as well as interims.

June—Congregation received orientation from Synod on transition.

June, July, August, 2024— A small group of council members met several times writing "essay" questions for the Ministry Site Profile (MSP).

July—Surveys (2) given to the congregation to fill out. Results are tabulated but not shared as yet.

September—Contract with each of the Splitts' was signed September 1<sup>st</sup> for 40 hours/week between them. They would take care of worship services, confirmation, weddings, funerals, attend meetings as necessary, congregational and hospital calls as necessary. They would make the judgment on "necessary."

October, 2024—Discussion of how to form the call committee.

October—Asked Holy Spirit lead formation of Call Team—still in process.

October 23, 2024--Met with council group to decide what to include in video presentation for the Ministry Site Profile (MSP).

Beginning the draft of the MSP for Council and Call Team.

**Steps to come**— Spiritual Direction Experiences and "Telling our Story" activity.

Sharing of MSP, Announcement of the Call Team.

All coming SOON we pray. BUT as we have learned, SOON is God's Time. Please be patient and pray with us as we wait asking God to "lead" us to the people. There is a team that is being formed and a from somewhere there is a pastor who will answer the call to St. John's, Norfolk.
