Sigiriya

Hotel – Habarana

Rising from the central plains, the iconic rocky outcrop of sigiriya is Perhaps sri lanka's single most dramatic sight. Near-vertical walls Soar to a flat-topped summit that contains the ruins of an ancient Civilisation, thought to be once the epicentre of the short-lived Kingdom of kassapa, and there are spellbinding Vistas across mist-wrapped forests in the early morning. Sigiriya Refuses to reveal its secrets easily, and you'll have to climb a series Of vertiginous staircases attached to sheer walls to reach the top. On the way you'll pass a series of quite remarkable frescoes and A pair of colossal lion's paws carved into the bedrock. The surrounding landscape – lily-pad-covered moats, Water gardens and quiet shrines – and the excellent site museum, only add to sigiriya's rock-star appeal.



Minneriya National Park

Large numbers of Sri Lankan elephants are attracted to grass fields on the edges of the reservoir during the dry season. The Minneriya tank contributes to sustain a large herd. Elephants gathered here is numbering around 150-200. Some reports account number of Elephants to as high as 700





Polonnaruwa

Ritigala

Ritigala is an ancient Buddhist monastery
and mountain in Sri Lanka. The ruins and rock
inscriptions of the monastery date
back to 1st century BCE.
It is located 43 km away from the ancient
monastic city of Anuradhapura



Dambulla cave temple



This temple complex dates back to the first century
BCE. It has five caves under a vast overhanging rock,
carved with a drip line to keep the interiors dry.
In 1938 the architecture was embellished with
arched colonnades and gabled entrances.
Inside the caves, the ceilings are painted with
intricate patterns of religious images following the
contours of the rock. There are images of the Lord
Buddha and bodhisattvas, as well as various gods and
goddesses.

Temple of the sacred Tooth

Sri Dalada Maligawa or the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic is a Buddhist temple in the city of Kandy, Sri Lanka. It is located in the royal palace complex of the former Kingdom of Kandy, which houses the relic of the tooth of the Buddha.



Royal Botanical Gardens, Peradeniya

The origins of the Botanic Gardens date as far back as 1371 when King Wickramabahu III ascended the throne and kept court at Peradeniya near the Mahaweli river. This was followed by King Kirti Sri and King Rajadhi Rajasinghe. A temple was built on this location by King Wimala Dharma, but it was destroyed by the British when they were given control over the Kingdom of Kandy.

Thereafter, the groundwork for a botanical garden was formed by Alexander Moon in 1821. He used the garden for coffee and cinnamon plants. The Botanical Garden at Peradeniya was formally established in 1843 with plants brought from Kew Garden, Slave Island, Colombo, and the Kalutara Garden in Kalutara. The Royal Botanic Garden, Peradeniya was made more independent and expanded under George Gardner as superintendent in 1844. On Gardner's death in 1849 George Henry Kendrick Thwaites became superintendent. He served until he resigned in 1879, when he was succeeded by Henry Trimen, who served until 1895. Horton Plains are the headwaters of three major Sri Lankan rivers, the Mahaweli, Kelani, and Walawe. In Sinhala the plains are known as Maha Eliya Plains. Stone tools dating back to Balangoda culture have been found here. The plains' vegetation is grasslands interspersed with montane forest, and includes many endemic woody plants. Large herds of Sri Lankan sambar deer feature as typical mammals, and the park is also an Important Bird Area with many species not only endemic to Sri Lanka but restricted to the Horton Plains. Forest dieback is one of the major threats to the park and some studies suggest that it is caused by a natural phenomenon
