Mission Statement

U-Pick Program & Fee's

One to five day morning OR afternoon programs commencing at 9:00am /12:45 pm, with dismissal at 11:30am / 3:20 pm.

Registration Fee:

The registration is a \$40.00 annual, non-refundable fee and ensures your child a spot at Little People's Preschool.

All Tuition Fees are annually based and may be financed over ten equal monthly payments.

Table Time / Crafts

Table time is when the students work on building their fine motor skills. Activities include Tabletop toys, Pre-printing, scissor skills, puzzles and crafts.

Circle Time

Circle Time is when the children will learn good listening and observation skills. Also they will learn about respect for those talking, turn taking and patience. During circle time children will sing songs& dance, be introduced to our learning goals and about the various themes we will study. Little People's Preschool will try to provide children with as many different opportunities as possible to learn educational concepts. We hope to explore math, language arts, fine arts (drama, drawing, painting), science, physical education, and health and wellbeing to mention a few.

Free Play

Free Play is a very important part of your child's daily routine. This is the time when children choose their own activities and Interact with their class mates. A lot of social development occurs as children discover the ins-and-outs of sharing, who has the same interests as them, and how to verbalize their wants in a manner that is most effective in getting those needs met.

Gym Time

The students will play games, explore the gym equipment, take turns, practice listening and following directions, develop and improve their Gross Motor skills

Show & Tell

Show & Tell is the perfect opportunity for students to take center stage. This is a special time for students that they enjoy very much. A child's self expression, as well as his or her social awareness are awakened during Show & Tell Time. Along with these aspects, Show & Tell offers the student audience the opportunity to formulate, who, what, where, when, why and how questions.
