Time to Spare League

This league will bowl every other Friday at 6:45pm starting September 12th for a total of 15 weeks. Practice will start at 6:30. Last night will be March 27. 2026

1) FEES: to be paid the first night.

\$15.00 per bowler per week for dues - \$11.50 goes to lineage and 3.50 to prize fund.

\$15.00 secretary fee per bowler

\$10.00 for basic sanction fees (men and women are the same) unless sanctioned in another league currently. The basic will have the trinket prizes unless you pay the full 25.00

Simple math for tonight: 40.00 per bowler

- 2) For the last week of bowling, I will be collecting all monies on week 14, so that I can put together all the prize funds, etc. The last week is sweeper week and that is a separate prize fund of 5.00 per bowler. That will be in addition to the 15.00 that is owed for last week. If you are absent the last night, you will still owe the 15.00 but not the 5.00.
- 3) Bowlers can pay ahead for remaining season if they choose to do so. Do not include the sweeper week. I will Collect that week 14.

4) RULES:

a) Handicap will be 90% of 220. We will use last years final averages tonight for Averages, any new bowlers will establish averages the first night they bowl, unless they have book averages from previous year.

We will be using book average/ending average from previous year (or new established average) for first 6 games.

- b) Absent scores for those that did not pre-bowl will be 10 pins under average.
- c) If a team is absent with no pre-bowled scores of at least one player, the opposing team does not automatically win they must bowl within 40 pins of their team average to earn the points.
- d) You may pre-bowl at any time before Friday. See email with information on pre bowling times. If you know you need to pre-bowl well in advance, make sure the dates for the night you will be missing is Accurate on the pre-bowl sheet. Please keep a copy for yourself and notify me.
- e) Roster line up can be a maximum of 6 players. If a team with a more than 4 bowlers have an absent bowler, you must take the bowler with most games bowled. If that number is equal, it is lowest average used next. A legal line up will have a minimum of 1 legal bowler. You can bring in subs for all other spots. Pacers can bowl too.
- f) The league can have a pool list of subs. Any team can use the subs that others have used if they so choose to. For sub scores to count, they must sanction. If they do not sanction, the missing bowler average will be used minus 10 pins and the sub is a pacer. Subs are not eligible for individual monetary awards.

- g) Bowlers showing up after the first ball of the 5th frame will use their average minus 10 pins and they can bowl the next two games. Again, it will be left to the individual teams if they choose to allow something different.
- 5) Recap sheets will need to be completely filled out and turned in to the counter.
- 6) Envelopes: I keep track of total money paid in envelope each week, I take note if I don't see a bowler here; however, it is up to each individual team to know who is paid and not paid.
- 7) Ties at end of season will be done through a one game roll off.
- 8) Please also make sure that there is room for both teams to keep their beverages, food, etc as every team has visitors that come. No wet shoes or bags on the lanes. Leave on the carpeted areas.
- 9) The last night of bowling, we will do monetary prize payouts. At that time we will discuss need for captains meeting at beginning of 2026 season. That will be held at 6pm first night of bowling in September. Please let me know who each team captain will be.
