## India Pale Ale & Imperial IPA

IPA or India Pale Ale is similar in style to pale ale with more robust hopping and stronger alcohol content. Imperial IPAs (aka- Double IPA's) are very strong usually 7.5% Alcohol by Volume (abv) and up and can be quite bitter, sweet, or very sweet.

A True Porter should be rich with malt, chocolate and roasty flavors. Stout is very dark, almost black with rich flavors due to the addition of dark, roasted grain. Rich malt flavors can be dry or sweet, strong, or mild.
