

#### **India Pale Ale & Imperial IPA**

IPA or India Pale Ale is similar in style to pale ale with more robust hopping and stronger alcohol content. Imperial IPAs (aka- Double IPA's) are very strong usually 7.5% Alcohol by Volume(abv) and up and can be quite bitter, sweet, or very sweet.
