
Using route numbers makes it easier for emergency personnel to find you on provincial government roads. Roads are numbered, not named. Dispatch will be able to identify where you are and give clear instructions to responders especially if they are not from the area.

The provincial government roads:

- Route 90 (Salmonier Line).
- Route 91 (Nine Mile) is technically Old Placentia Road as it runs right from Route 90 to South East. Placentia.
- Route 93 starts at the head intersection (Main Road North) and carries on to the Harricott Road intersection and right on to Colinet.
- Route 93-10 from Harricott Road intersection to the point it is Route 93-10 an offshoot of 93 as it is a dead end.

Please ensure your civic number is visible on the road from BOTH directions.
