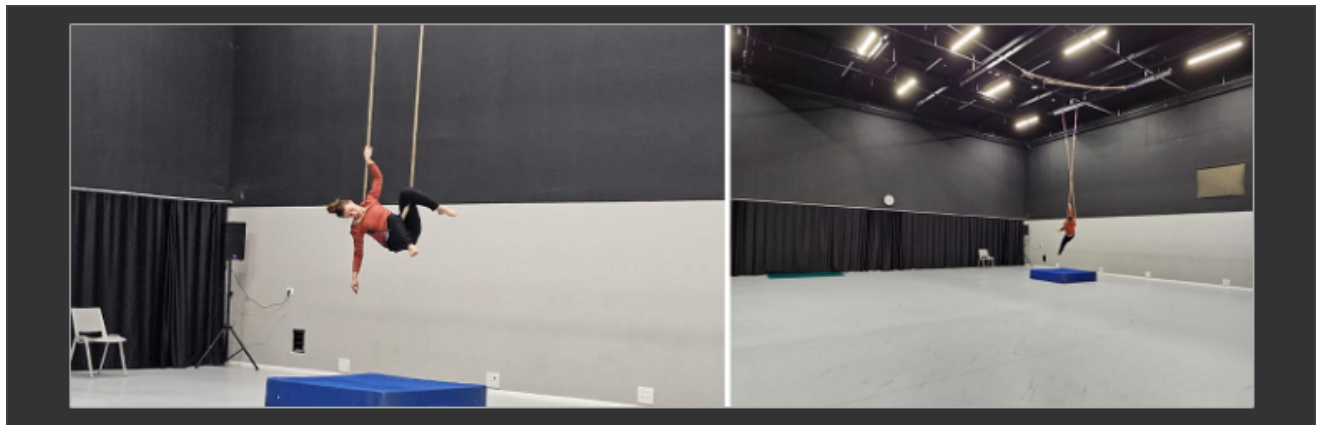

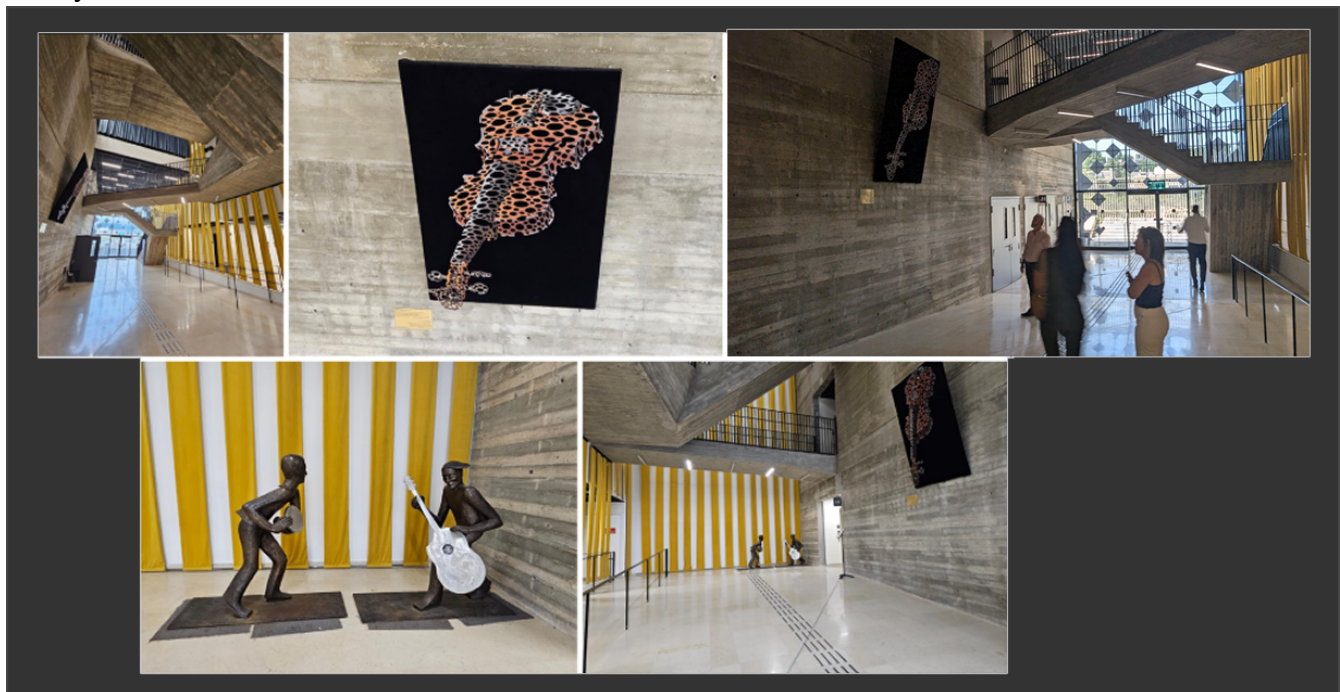

Lobby - 250,000USD

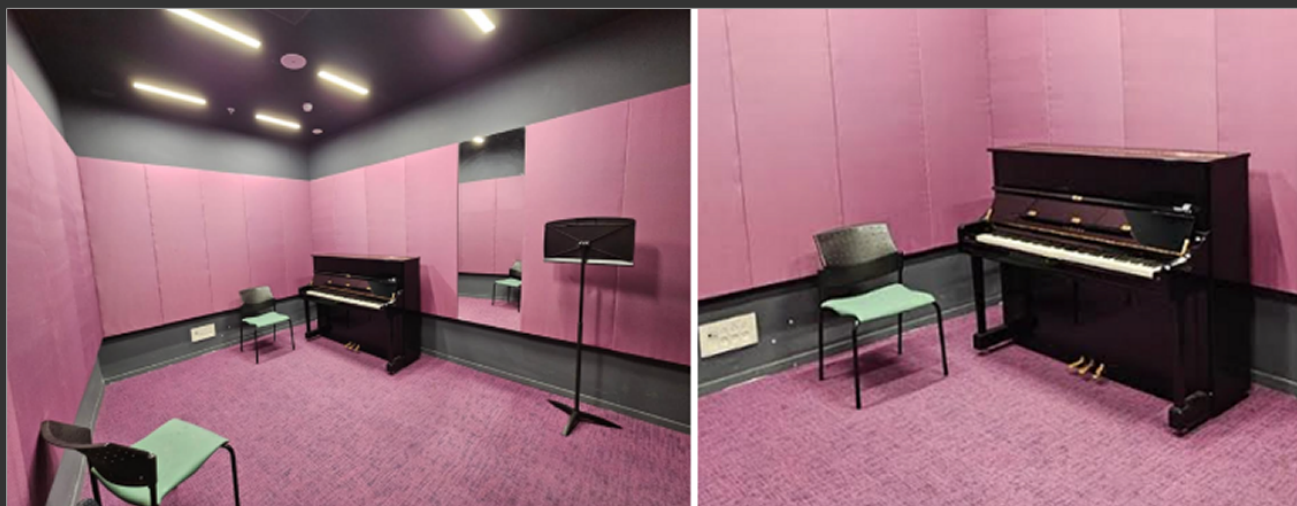


New Technology Room - USD 150,000

Outdated mailboxes will be removed, and in their place, we will create a **welcoming, efficient, and respectful waiting area** that reflects the excellence and dignity of our Academy. This renovation will not only streamline student support but also enhance the overall experience of nearly 1,000 multi-ethnic and multi-faith students who rely on these services daily.
