Showing a growth of \$21,645.37. Includes a \$5,000.00 donation of which portions of will be transferred to the #1,000 to the Auxiliary, \$1,000 to the Sons and \$2,000 to the Sea Cadets. Will transfer \$1,082.27 (5% of profit) to maintenance account.
