The Legion Riders are collective members of the American Legion organization and one of the nation's most prominent supporters of veterans, military, and their families.

**Who is eligible to apply?**

- McMinnville, Perrydale, Amity, Dayton, Willamina and Sheridan (with qualifying Veteran) graduating student, going on to a college, trade school or technical school.
- This scholarship is also available to veteran qualified students going directly into a trade and need assistance with tools, clothing etc.
- A student with a minimum GPA of 2.0
- Proof of a parent/guardian, grandparent, or sibling being in the military (past or current service).

**When is the deadline?**

The application and all required materials can be submitted to the above address or school counselor, but all applications must be to the Legion Riders committee no later than **second Friday in May**

**How do I apply? To be completed by student**

1. Complete the attached application
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation ( 1 from faculty)
3. Personal essay
4. Copy of your high school or home school transcript.

Materials submitted for a scholarship award will not be returned. To ensure no original materials are lost or destroyed; all materials submitted should be copies. Applications will be reviewed and voted on by the scholarship committee members. Scholarship funds will be awarded one time only.

If awarded, Proof of Enrollment in a school and the address of the school is required. Funds will then be released to the student. If the student drops out of school before that term is finished, repayment of the scholarship is the onerous and good conscience of the recipient.

  4. **Attach a copy of your** Qualifying Veteran **military record** or current status. DD214
  5. Attach all paperwork together and contact ALR member listed above or give to school counselor to send on to above address
