Review of Minutes: Motion by Rich Pimm that the minutes be approved as presented, seconded by Leroy Brown - Passed.

Finance Report: Post Account \$32,630.54; Lottery Account \$39,925.45 – Total Accounts = \$72,555.99. Total Liquid Assets = \$20,249.93 = Total Assets = \$92,805.92. Continued work on reconciliation completed through June 2108, expect to be complete within the next two weeks. Online registration of website \$299.00.

Commanders Report: Looking for a bid to fix drainage issues in parking lot. Bid will not include repair of asphalt. Golf Tournament July 25, 2020 – PIC Dan & Shirley Brown.

Next month we will start nominations for officers. Steve Farley will not be running for office. Need a new commander, please consider running for office.

Mr. Farley explained he received information two weeks ago regarding a fund raiser. Set for June 26-27 (during convention). Last year they raised \$10,000 for Autism Charity. Visited Alice Blakely-Smith at Willamette Valley Cancer Center, she asked Thomas to do her eulogy. Volunteer Hours – Army 102.5; Marines 94/5; Navy 109.75; Air Force 64.5 total 371.25 hours. Hours to date are 6,693.5.

Historian: Had a visit from the VA regarding in home VA care. Mr. Brown presented an outline for a proposal to recognize the men and women who have fought for our country in the War on Terror. Would like to see it modeled around the Warm Springs Veterans Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Parade. Would like to do this when we have our Centennial in August 2020. Would like to be able to hand those being recognized something, i.e. challenge coin, t-shirt, ball cap open to suggestions. Would like to have it coincide with our Veterans Day Parade in November.

Motion by Jim Connelly that Mr. Brown go forward and gather information needed to proceed with program of recognizing those who have served since 9/11 – Seconded by Cody Pankey – **Passed**.
