7. True\_\_\_ False\_\_\_                      Texas is believed to be a sovereign nation today. After the Battle of the Alamo, from February 23 thru March 6, 1836 was won by the Mexican Army, the Texian soldiers defeated the Mexican Army at the Battle of San Jacinto on April 21, 1836. It was then that the republic of Texas became a nation by Treaty. The 1836 Treaty was signed by the President of Mexico when he and his armies were defeated in San Jacinto. Texians quickly formed a government and signed international treaties in France, Yucatan, the Netherlands and other nations. These treaties are valid to this day.
8. True\_\_\_ False\_\_\_                      The republic of Texas was never lawfully annexed to the united States by Treaty. The only way the United States could bypass its supreme Treaty law and get control of the Texian (people only not the lands) was by trickery. Therefore, in 1844 there was a midnight passing of an unlawful corporate resolution outside the constitutional laws of the United States of America. This resolution was done while most congressmen were away on recess. The 1845 Charter, incorporated and chartered the State of Texas and the Texian people were tricked into thinking they had a government of and by the people. **This scam is still carried on today. Creating so-called Texan persons out of the Internationally known Texian people was the most astounding trick of all.**
