All of the vendors I spoke with were happy with how everything went. They've all said that we do a great job as hosts for the show, so we should be proud of what






New wheels, new classes

Faceting Shop has been busy lately





We have a Graves faceting machine for sale. If you know someone who's interested in getting into faceting, it's a decent starter machine. It's missing a few things, like dops and cutting plates. But the bonus for buying it is that it also comes with the first class of the faceting course built into the price.

Beginning Faceting classes

Here are dates for upcoming faceting classes:

- May 4-5, 9 a.m.-3 p.m.
- May 18-19, 9 a.m.-3 p.m. This is a two-day introductory class on cutting faceted gemstones (transparent stones similar in appearance to diamonds). The following topics will be covered in the class:
- Choosing cutting material
- Stone dopping
- Facet cutting
- Transferring a stone
- Facet polishing

Students will also be taught the proper operation and care of a faceting machine. Each student will complete one stone.

Cost is \$210 total, which includes materials, instructor fee, club shop time and use of machines. A deposit of \$110 is required to reserve a seat. The balance should be paid directly to the instructor on the first day of class.

Each student should have his/her own Optivisor to closely examine the stone during the cutting process. These are available on Amazon or Harbor Freight.

Lapidary Open Shop Reservations

Members who completed the Beginning Cabochon class may use equipment in the Lapidary Shop during Open Shop. You must present your shop pass to the monitor when you sign in. If you do not have a card, ask the monitor or shop foreman for one. If you have previous cabbing experience, but did not take the Beginning Cabochon class, talk to the shop foreman for a Skill Check to get your shop pass. You must be a current member to use club facilities. Cost is \$5 per hour. PayPal or exact change only.

Metal Open Shop Reservations

Members who completed the Beginning Silver course may use the Metal Shop during Open Shop. You must present your shop pass to the monitor when you sign in. If you do not have a card, ask the monitor or shop foreman for one. If you have previous smithing experience, but did not take the Beginning class, talk to the shop foreman for a Skill Check to get your shop pass. You must be a current member. Cost is \$5 per hour. PayPal or exact change only.




