(Cabs will be provided for the first basket) You will learn the slant/single stitch and how to add a new thread and change colors. Coil the bottom, then learn to shape the sides and add beads! Depending on your skill level, you may not finish in class but you will learn to finish on your own. Students may work on the basket between classes. A second basket may be started and kits and supplies will be available.

Class kits include: Cabochon glued onto leather to start weaving on, 3 colors of waxed linen threads, pine needles, and beads! Extra supplies will be available.
