Hawk Mountain Trip - Saturday, September 28

It's autumn migration when over 18,000 birds of prey will pass over Hawk Mountain Sanctuary - broad-winged hawks, kestrels, vultures, ospreys, bald eagles and more. We'll spend the day enjoying incredible views as these raptor migrants pass overhead.



Enjoy a guided hike to the North Lookout or you may prefer to join those choosing a more casual walk to the South Lookout via the ADA accessible trail. We'll also spend time at the Visitor Center and the two-acre Native Plant Garden.

Bring your binoculars (if you have) and a packed lunch. We will leave from St Paul's promptly at 9:00 am.

Trail fees are \$10 for adults, \$7 for Seniors, and \$5 for children 6-12. Five and under are free. Sunday School children will also be free.
