HOSPITAL CHAPLAINCY

The Chaplaincy team at York and Scarborough NHS Trust are there to support not only patients, but also visitors, carers and staff. Our main role is to be a comforting presence at times of difficulty and distress, to listen and give support, as well as providing faith-based support, prayer and sacraments, as required.

If you know someone who is in hospital, please get in touch if they may appreciate a visit from the chaplaincy team for support. We always check with the patient whether they want to be seen and gain their consent for visits. You can phone us on the numbers below or email us to make a referral.

Chaplains can also be called out 24/7 in emergencies or for end-of-life support. **Families need to ask the ward staff to contact the switchboard operator, to request the on-call chaplain.** There are Catholic Priests also available on-call (please, inform the ward staff that you are asking for a Catholic Priest). For Catholics, priests are asked to visit the patient while they are still conscious so that they can receive the sacraments of confession, Eucharist and anointing of the sick. Sometimes we are asked too late when the patient had already passed away. Please, pass this vital information to your families.

More Information:

The chaplaincy team consists of 8 staff, 7 honorary chaplains and around 30 volunteers. We are based in York and Scarbrough Hospitals, but we also visit patients in other locations such as Malton, Bridlington and Selby Hospitals, St Monica's Easingwold, Nelsons Court, White Cross Court and Saint Catherine's Hospice in Scarborough.

Most people think that chaplaincy is only for people with a strong faith, but the team are here for everyone – for people with any faith and no faith. Our staff and volunteers visit patients on the wards to firstly offer pastoral support – a listening ear, emotional support, and help with fear and loneliness. In terms of spiritual support, we listen to people's life stories to help them find hope, peace, comfort and strength in hard times. In terms of religious support, we offer prayers, blessings, holy communion, faith-based conversations and signposting to multi-faith support. We also support many patients and their families at end of life, offering prayers and anointing; as well as offering baby loss support, with naming and blessings.
