



**11th February: Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes**  
**World day of prayer for the sick 2026**



Pope Leo XIV's message for the 34th World Day of the Sick 2026, centres on the inseparability of love for God and love for neighbour, presenting service to the sick as a tangible expression of Divine love. Human actions, including service to others, must flow from this divine love, transcending self-interest: *"To serve one's neighbour is to love God through deeds."* The Holy Father urges a Christian lifestyle rooted in fraternal love. He hopes for a "Samaritan" spirit—welcoming, courageous, committed, and supportive—enkindled by union with God and faith in Christ, enabling self-gift to the sick, elderly, and afflicted. The message concludes with an invocation to Mary:

***Sweet Mother, do not part from me.  
Turn not your eyes away from me.  
Walk with me at every moment and never leave me alone.  
You who always protect me as a true Mother, obtain for me  
the blessing of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.  
Amen.***

In our parishes, to celebrate the World Day of Prayer for the Sick, we are having these **Healing Masses**:

- Monday, 9th February - St George's Church Eastfield at 10am;
- Tuesday, 10th February - St Mary's Church, Filey at 10am;
- Wednesday, 11th February - Our Lady & St Peter Church, Bridlington at 12noon.

On the 11th February, Mass in Bridlington will be at 12 noon, including the sacrament of the Sick, followed by a small inside church procession and the rosary. Masses on **Ash Wednesday** (18th February):

- Our Lady & St Peter, Bridlington: 10am; 6pm

During Lent, **Stations of the Cross** follows every week day Mass and 20minutes before Mass at weekend Masses.
