Masses on Ash Wednesday (18th February):

- Our Lady & St Peter, Bridlington: 10am; 6pm
- St Mary, Filey: 10am
- St George, Eastfield: 12noon

During Lent, **Stations of the Cross** follows every week day Mass and 30minutes before Mass on Friday and weekend Masses.
