

## **2018 FHSU student storage information**

### **Dorm room storage:**

**Regular dorm room storage** - \$120 for the summer. Your property will be stored in a cube measuring 42" wide, 72" long and 36" high. Plenty of space for most dorm rooms.

**Large dorm room storage** - \$170 for the summer. Double the space. If you have futon, bookshelf, bike or other large object or if you have above average belongings you will likely need this size. You can also save \$ and split this size with another student.

All dorm room items must be boxed or wrapped with bubble wraps or shrink wrap. TV's must be boxed. Items with drawers must be shrink wrapped. We have box kits available for \$35 that have everything you will need to store your items properly. We have climate controlled storage available for sensitive items like TV's, computers, printers, etc.. You may store up to 2 items in climate controlled storage. The remainder of your items will be placed in conventional storage.

Items may be brought to our Hays location for storage. We usually allow students to start bringing their stuff up to 1 week before school is out.

We accept cash, check, and all major credit cards. Credit cards can be called in.

We are not responsible for damage – make sure your items are properly packed and protected. If you are concerned about valuable items, you are advised to have them insured through a renters or homeowners policy. Standard self storage policies apply – you will be issued a rental agreement to sign.

Items must be picked up no later than September 1, 2018. If you are needing storage beyond that date please call us to make arrangements.

We are a U-haul dealer and have pickups, cargo vans and small moving trucks available for rent. Call us at 785 639 7368 or go to [u-haul.com](http://u-haul.com) to make a reservation.

### **Apartment Storage**

We have a limited number of small storage units available on a first come first served basis. If you are needing to store your apartment our advice is to CALL NOW and get a unit rented. You will have to pay rent before you need the unit, however rates increase in May and are hard to come by so you will be money ahead by renting now.

If you are needing storage longer term, such as studying abroad for a semester, we have a few units set aside for that as well.
