## How can you serve Hideaway?

Hideaway is a wonderful place to live! Do you have some time to help make it even better? One way you can help is to serve on our Board of Aldermen.

In 2022 we will have an election for three seats on our Board of Aldermen. Normally each year there are two seats up for election and in odd number years there are two aldermen seats open plus the mayor's office. However, Richard Peacock moved out of Hideaway in 2021 and your current Board of Aldermen appointed Steve Johnston to fill his remaining term. This seat will be available for election in 2022 plus two other seats. All aldermen seats are "at large" and, as such, all aldermen represent all of Hideaway

If you would like to run for alderman, you need to file for a place on the ballot please submit your application by turning it in to the receptionist at the Member Services Building. The filing form is available at this same location. NOTE: The City of Hideaway requires voter registration in the City of Hideaway. An application for a place on the general election ballot must be filed not later than 5 p.m. on Friday February 12<sup>th</sup>. Election Day in 2022 is Saturday, May 7, 2022.

## Method of Filing Application.

- a. Mail. An application filed by mail is considered filed at the time of its receipt by the appropriate authority. The time of receipt is the time at which a post office employee:
  - i. Places it in the actual possession of the authority or an agent; or
  - ii. Deposits it in the authority's mailbox or at the usual place of delivery for the authority's official mail. [Sec. 1.009]
- Filing in Person: Submit form at the Hideaway Member Services Building as indicated above.
- c. Filing by Fax or Email: A signed, sworn, scanned candidate application (and petition, if applicable) may be submitted by fax or email if there is no filing fee. The filing authority must establish a dedicated email address for the submission of candidate applications. This fax number or email address should be posted on the Notice of Deadline to File Applications for Place on the Ballot (PDF) or wherever information about filing candidate applications is posted, including your website notice. Please be advised that an application must be notarized (or otherwise sworn to before someone authorized to administer an oath under Texas law) prior to filing via fax or email.
