I recently met with the Sheriff and members of his staff to ask this question and others in relation to our security in Hideaway. A recent court decision has set a precedent that law enforcement CAN arrest for DWI within our gates. The judge ruled that communities like ours are "generally open to the public" and therefore subject to being charged if they are driving impaired. I am not a lawyer, nor do I claim to fully understand the court ruling, but I am meeting with the Sheriff again and I plan to ask him to hold a question-and-answer session with our citizens at a date to be determined. We will advertise when and where this will take place and I encourage you to attend. We have an outstanding relationship with Sheriff Larry Smith and his entire staff, and we will continue to nurture that relationship for the betterment of all of our citizens.
