The regular public meeting of September 14, 2021 was called to order at 2:00 PM by Mayor Ray Hutcheson. In addition to the Mayor, Sample, Ferrell, and Hoffman were present. Then Mayor Hutcheson said a short prayer.

The Mayor then asked if there were any changes to the minutes from the last meeting. After some discussion, Alderman Sample moved that approval of the minutes be postponed until facts could be clarified. Alderman Hoffman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Alderman Hoffman was asked to give his financial report and proposed budget for year 2021-2022. Since there were no guests, the regular meeting didn't need to be closed for discussion on the budget. Alderman Hoffman moved that the monthly financials be approved. Alderman Samples seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Then discussion of the budget followed. Alderman Sample moved that the budget be accepted as printed and Alderman Ferrell seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Alderman Mullins then arrived late for the meeting.

The Mayor then called upon Alderman Ferrell about the paperwork to have an "Authorized Septic Agent" in Hideaway. She reported that the contact had been

signed by the Mayor and mailed back to the law firm. She gave the secretary a copy to be filed. Some discussion followed.

The schedule for the City Aldermen meetings for next year was then discussed. Due to some Aldermen having problems with the current time and day, it was decided that next year meetings would be held on Friday at 2PM. The Mayor will send out the dates for next year to the Aldermen.

Due to time restraints the recommendations for a "Mission Statement" for the city and any further agenda items were postponed until the next meeting on November 19 at 2PM.

The Mayor then adjourned the meeting at 4:40 PM.
