Narrative: Lindale responded to report of a residential structure fire. Engine 2 arrived to find a single story, single family home with heavy smoke showing from the eaves and flames out the roof. Engine 2 pulled a 1 .75" landline and made entry in thru the garage. Engine 1 crew was assigned venting the roof. Engine 1 cut a vent hole in the roof over the fire, and then pulled a second line to assist E2 crew. Fire appeared to have started behind the fire place, and extended up to the attic. R2 crew was assigned to salvage of belongings. Crew pulled additional roofing and walls to ensure the fire was out. SCFM arrived and investigated. Crews then assisted with removing all firefighting water from the home. L-17 turned the home back over to the resident, and all units cleared and returned.
