

Good Afternoon,

Your club and the City of Hideaway are working diligently to prepare our community for the Coronavirus. The city does not have an email database, so they are working with the club to send out periodic emails to keep our residents informed. You should have received one yesterday. Please watch your inbox for additional updates. If a resident of Hideaway is diagnosed with the coronavirus, the diagnosing medical professional will report it to the Northeast Texas Public Health District (NET Health) and that organization will inform the city and issue a public statement, without the name of the individual, but with information regarding where that individual lives.

The City of Hideaway is a General Law City and as such, under state law, can declare a state of emergency if necessary. If an emergency is declared, you will be notified by both email and a Code Red phone message. As of right now, there are 3 reported cases of the coronavirus in Smith County. We will keep you updated on any developing cases. Please rest assured that your city and club are doing everything within reason to protect our wonderful community.
