# The Rules and Regulations for cooks at the 10th Annual Pleasant Hill Lodge # 380

## A.F. & A.M. John Crowhurst Memorial Chili Cook-off are as follows:

- Traditional Red Chili** is defined as any kind of meat or combination of meats, cooked with red chili peppers, various spices and other ingredients, with the exception of BEANS and PASTA which are strictly forbidden. Judges will be told that they should vote for the chili based on the following major considerations: good chili flavors, texture of the meat, consistency, blend of spices, aroma and color. No ingredient may be pre-cooked in any way prior to the commencement of the official cook-off. The only exceptions are canned or bottled tomatoes, tomato sauce, peppers, pepper sauce, beverages, broth and grinding and/or mixing of spices. Meat may be treated, pre-cut or ground. **MEAT MAY NOT BE PRE-COOKED**, in any manner. All other ingredients must be chopped or prepared during the preparation period. The cooking period will be a minimum of 3 hours and a maximum of 4 hours. Judging samples need to be turned in by 12:00 and winners will be announced by 4:00 pm.
- The gates will open for set up at 6:00 am Saturday **May 8, 2021**. Set up can not begin until then. Cooking will start after 8:00 am but not before and must start by 9:00 am. Cooking during entire cooking period is at the sole discretion of the contestant. Samples are to be served to the public from 12:00 noon till you run out of beans and chili. Please do not leave your station unattended or leave before 5:00 or until all of your chili or beans have been sampled to the public.
- We will conduct a contestant's meeting at 7:00 am at which instructions are to be given and questions answered.
- Contestants are responsible for supplying all their own cooking utensils and heat source and all contestants are responsible for the removal of their own trash. We will provide an area for each contestant to set up their cooking and serving stations, and stations will be assigned on a first come first serve basis.
- Each contestant must cook a minimum of four gallons of competition chili or beans prepared in one pot of which 1 quart will be submitted for judging.
- Each contestant will be assigned a contestant's number by the Chief Scorekeeper and given an official 1-quart judging cup. For a cook to receive the judging cup for their specific contest, they must sign the contestant list and have entry fee paid in advance. Each contestant should verify that the number on the bottom of their cup is the same as their assigned contestant number. Each contestant is responsible to deliver his or her cup, which must be filled to the bottom of the cup's rim, to the judging area at the official time for judging.
- Please follow these rules to ensure the competition is fair. Any violation of these rules may result in disqualification. We want to have fun and raise money for a good cause, and of course enjoy some healthy competition.

# The Rules and Regulations for Vendors at the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Pleasant Hill Lodge # 380 John Crowhurst Memorial Chili Cook-off are as follows:

- 1. Food Vendors will be allowed if pre-approved we will try to avoid any vendors selling the same products so everyone will have success. Packaged food and canned or jarred food may be permitted in a retail space if pre-approved.
- 2. **Set up will start at 8:00 am Saturday May 8, 2021, please be set up by 9:30 am.** We will open the doors to the public from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm. Please do not take your booth down or leave it unattended until after 5:00 pm. Vehicles will not be allowed to remain parked around the pavilion. Once unloaded all vehicles will be parked in the adjacent parking area.
- 3. All vendors will be responsible for all set up and tear down of booths, and providing your own tents, tables or any other items needed. You will be furnished a 10ft by 10ft booth space on a first come first serve basis and all vendors are asked to use only their pre-assigned booth space. Each vendor will be responsible for removal of all his or her trash.
