Christmas Show

'Tis the year of running things differently. After much thought and consideration, we decided that we would not be holding our traditional Christmas Show. Here's what we are going to do instead:

- Dancers are currently rehearsing Christmas dances
- The week before we break for Christmas (December 14-19 2020) dancers will arrive to their regular dance class ready to perform their dance. Dancers will take to the stage and perform their dance while we record it.
- We will take the time to edit all the dances together to make a video for you to enjoy at home. You will get to view all the other classes as well. Each video will be broken down by day so it is easy for you to find your dancer's class.
- We typically charge a small admission fee at our Christmas show. This covers the cost of staff, rentals for the show as well as acts as a fundraiser for JNS Dance. In the past this has helped us purchase new mats and equipment, flooring, etc. Since there is no admission this year, we are instead asking that you pay a small fee for the link to the videos. You are able to share the video with the rest of your family as well. But we ask that you do not share with other families and please do not post publicly for the privacy of the other dancers. Thank you.
- The fee is \$5 *per dancer* to receive the links to all of the dances. However, with COVID-19 effecting so many households this year, we will happily offer a "Pay What You Can" option or wave the fee all together. Please speak to Miss Julie before hand if this is the case.
- The fee will be due the week we record the dances. You can send it along with your dancer to class, or email transfer to danceindorchester@gmail.com
