Dear Lake Harney Estates Homeowners,

Our goal over the last calendar year has been to maintain the miles of dirt roads in our community. This last year we have:

- Backfilled and graded roads after Hurricane Milton
- Graded the road over 7 times, some roads were graded more than others based on the individual road condition
- Over 15 loads of fill and gravel has been delivered and spread
- A number of volunteers have pulled a drag to help knock down the wash boarded areas
- Others have helped maintain the small culverts and drains that help funnel the water off the road and into the drainage ditches
- We are always on the lookout to ensure the main thoroughfares are regularly maintained

We have done all this while tightening our budget by cutting back on frequency of services, eliminating ditch mowing, taking direct responsibility for grading the roads using shared equipment and our own personal vehicles and streamlined the association processes such as only using a contractor when needed.

We are a voluntary Association and have kept the dues to \$250/year despite increased costs of materials and labor. Last year a little more than a third of the eligible homeowners contributed to the Association. At this level of participation, we are only able to do limited maintenance and we are unable to replenish our financial reserves for future major storm repairs.

It has been determined by the actions of Seminole County that maintaining our roads is on us. If we do not do it, we cannot expect that the county will maintain them. We believe some homeowners that do not pay assume that if we are not able to maintain the roads ourselves, the county will come in and maintain them or even pave them for us. Unfortunately, this is not the case.

For the current year, we hope your household will contribute towards the upkeep of our roads. Please encourage your neighbors to contribute as well. We all care about being able to get to and from our homes and keeping the roads in good condition. Pooling our funds together through the Association is the most efficient way to do this.

It is important for our neighbors to pull together and be self-reliant with managing the shared roads in our neighborhood. It is important that if you see water pooling on the road in-front your house, please cut a path to the drainage ditch. Standing water on the roads deteriorate faster than roads that have good drainage.
