JUMPER DIVISION CLASS ORDER:

1st class: 11.1.a – Timed first Round only

2nd class: 11.2.c – Power & Speed: If the first portion round of the round is clean, rider will immediately continue onto timed the section of the course.

3rd class: 11.2.b – Following the first round, rider will exit ring and those who have completed the first round without faults will return for a timed second round after all first rounds are completed. This will be used as the Classic round for each division. Riders must show in the entire division to be eligible for prize money in the Classic.

The 50/50 Derby & Mini Prix will start with a minimum payout of \$1,000 and entries will close 30 minutes prior to the start. The "Prize Money Pot" will grow as each horse or pony enters the Derby or Mini Prix. Once you're entered into the Derby or Mini Prix if you scratch you will still be required to pay the \$50 towards The "Prize Money Pot". The Derby fee is \$100 per entry with 50% applied to the Prize Money Pot. Each rider's entry money will increase the "Pot" by \$50. Ribbons will be awarded up to 10th place with prize money paid out to 6th place.



Rules and Regulations

1. The horse show committee, show managers, show organizers, show staff, Above the Standard LLC, Above the Standard Show Series, Hunt For The Crown, Mathew or Ashley Brown, Show Grounds or property owners or any of its employees or affiliates will NOT be responsible for any damage, loss, theft, injury or death to persons, horse/pony, or property of any exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the show grounds. A liability waiver, COVID questionnaire & form MUST be signed for each exhibitor, participant, or spectator before entering the show grounds.
2. All persons are to wear a face mask unless mounted. Show management does hold the right to ask any person who does not follow the rules to leave the show grounds or ban them from all future Hunt for the Crown events.
3. Class Fees: \$25/Each, Post Entry Fee: \$35, Schooling Tickets: \$25. Multiple Schooling tickets may be purchased at management's discretion. Office Fee: \$10, EMT Fee \$5 and Medals/Classics: \$35/each. You must compete in the entire division to be eligible for the prize money. You must compete in one full division to be eligible to compete in the 50/50 Derby or Mini Prix.
 4. Must provide a negative coggins test dated within 1 year upon request.
5. Classes for Junior riders will be limited to riders that have not reached their 18th birthday prior to 12/1/21.
 6. ATSM helmets MUST be worn while mounted. NO EXCEPTIONS!
 7. The Judge's decision and Management decisions are final.
 8. No martingales shall be permitted during a flat class.
9. Divisions and classes will run as scheduled. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine divisions at their discretion. BREIF 10 minute Schooling breaks will be available with height changes.
 10. FOOD AND DRINKS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE.
 11. Entries and counts will be posted on Horseshowing.com
12. To receive full prize money payout money classes must have a minimum of 10 entries once the class starts. If the 10 rider minimum has not been achieved, payout will be reduced to 50%. All payouts are paid to riders 1-6th, 1st - 30%, 2nd - 22%, 3rd - 15%, 4th - 12%, 5th - 11%, 6th - 10%
13. POINTS WILL BE ACCRUED FOR MEMBERS OF ATSSS. YOU MUST BE A MEMBER FOR YOUR POINTS TO COUNT. IT IS NOT REQUIRED FOR EXHIBITORS TO BE MEMBERS TO COMPETE.
 14. ATSSS MEMBERSHIP FEE: \$40 AND \$15 FOR EACH ADDITIONAL HORSE.

Division & Class Specifications:

Baby Green: Open to riders, horses and ponies in their first and second year of showing. Open to all riders. Trotting in corners NOT to be penalized. (2')

TB Hunters: Only TB's are eligible. Judged on soundness, manners and way of going. (2' or 2'6)

Junior Equitation: Open to all junior riders and judged on equitation. (2', 2'6 or 3')

Adult Equitation: Open to all adult riders and judged on equitation. (2', 2'6 or 3')

Low Children's Horse: Open to Juniors on horses. Judged on mount. May NOT cross enter into Children's Hunter. (2'6)

Low Adult Hunter: Open to Adult Amateurs on horses. Judged on mount. May NOT cross enter into Adult Hunter. (2'6)

Children's Hunter Horse: Open to Junior riders on horses. Judged on mount. May not cross-enter into Low-Children's horse. (3')

Adult Hunters: Open to Adult Amateurs on horses. Judged on mount. May NOT cross enter into Low Adult hunters. (3')

Beginner Rider: Open to junior and adult riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. (X-Rails)

Developing Hunter: Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing regardless of age. Judged on Mount. (X-Rails)

Shortest Stirrup: 8 years old and under. May cross-enter into Pleasure Pony, Short Stirrup, Beginner rider. (X-Rails)

Short Stirrup: 10 years old and under. (X-Rails)

Short Stirrup Hunter: 10 years old and under. Judged on mount. (X-Rails)

Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders over the age of 18 who have not competed over 2' at any horse show. (X-Rails & 2')

Walk/Trot: Riders 10 and under. May cross-enter into any Walk/Trot class, but not eligible to canter.

Lead Line: 7 years old and under. May cross-enter into Walk/Trot & Shortest Stirrup ONLY.

Novice Eq: Open to riders who have not shown over a height of 2'. (2')

Modified Hunters: Open to all horses/ponies and riders. (2')

Pleasure Horse & Pony: Open to all riders, horses and ponies. Judged on manners, suitability, and soundness. (x-rails, 2' or 2'6)

Low Children's Pony: Open to Junior riders on ponies. Judged on mount. May NOT cross enter into Children's Pony. (2')

Children's Pony: Open to Junior riders on ponies. Judged in mount. May NOT cross enter into Low Children's Pony. (S/M:2' & L:2'6)

Medal Details: Class Fees \$35

Brownstone Farm Pony Medal: Open to all JUNIOR riders as of Dec 1st of the current show year. Riders may not have won any equitation class at 3'6 as of Dec. 1st of the current show year. S/M:2' & L:2'6

Foxtale Farm Low Children's/Adult 2'6 Medal: MUST show in the Low-Children's or Low-Adult Hunters. CANNOT cross enter into any other class or division with fence heights exceeding 2'6. Points accrued will count towards series end medal finals.

Mane Line Stables Children's/Adult 3' Medal: Riders must show in the Children's or Adult 3' hunter divisions. CANNOT cross enter into any class or division where the jumps exceed 3'. Points accrued will count towards series end medal finals.

Hunt for the Crown Short Stirrup X-Rails Medal: Riders must show in the Shortest, Short Hunter or Equitation divisions. CANNOT cross into any class or division where the jumps exceed x-rails.

Hidden Farm Hunters Novice 2' Medal: Riders must show in the Novice division. CANNOT cross into any class or division where the jumps exceed 2'.
