About CS Yachts

CS Yachts was a Canadian sailboat builder based in Ontario, established as a division of Hinterhoeller Yachts and later operating independently through the 1970s and 1980s. Known for producing solidly built, performance-oriented cruiser-racers, CS Yachts earned a loyal following among Great Lakes sailors for combining thoughtful ergonomics, quality fiberglass construction, and balanced sailing performance. Models like the CS 27, CS 30, CS 33, and CS 36 remain sought-after on the used sailboat market decades later, prized for their durability and seaworthiness.

Though CS Yachts ceased production in the late 1980s, the brand's reputation for craftsmanship has kept resale values and demand strong, particularly in Ontario, the Great Lakes region, and throughout North America. For sailors researching CS Yachts history, CS 30 specifications, or Canadian-built sailboats for sale, the marque continues to represent excellent value in the classic plastic segment of the used boat market.

The CS 30

The CS 30 is a 30-foot cruiser-racer sailboat introduced by CS Yachts as part of its well-regarded lineup of Canadian-built monohulls. Designed for sailors who want capable performance without sacrificing comfortable cruising accommodations, the CS 30 strikes a balance that has kept it popular on Lake Ontario, throughout the Great Lakes, and across North American cruising grounds for nearly four decades.

Below decks, the CS 30 offers a practical, cruiser-friendly layout: a forward Vee berth cabin with a hanging locker for offshore-style stowage, a comfortable salon with port and starboard settees and a bulkhead-mounted table, a private aft double berth tucked beneath the cockpit, a functional galley with a propane stove and oven, and an enclosed marine head. It's a layout well suited to weekend cruising, coastal passages, or club racing with a small crew.

Under sail, the CS 30 is powered by a dependable Volvo 18hp diesel auxiliary and is well set up for both racing and cruising, with North sails (mainsail, #1 genoa, and #3 genoa), Harken headsail furling, and four winches for efficient sail handling. Deck gear including a windlass, dodger, and bimini add cruising comfort and shorthanded convenience.

Orenda, this particular 1986 CS 30, is in good condition and comes well-equipped for her next owner, with modern navigation electronics, recent batteries, and a steel folding cradle for winter storage — making her an excellent turnkey option for buyers searching "CS 30 for sale," "sailboats for sale Toronto," or "used sailboats Lake Ontario."
